Remarks Friday June 11th 1857.

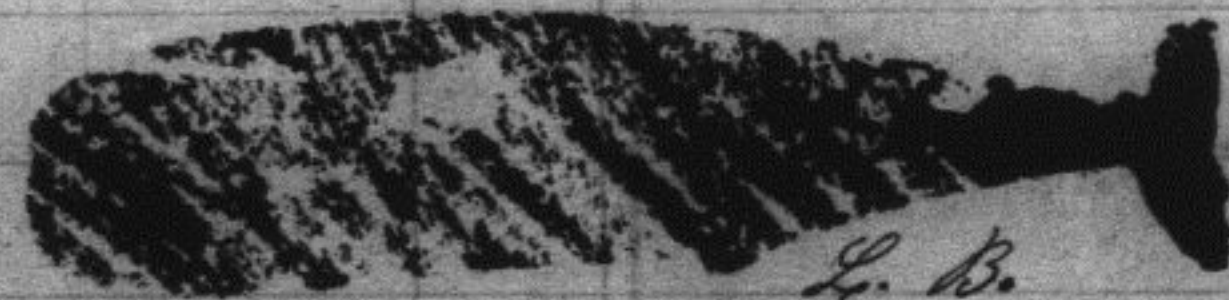
at 9 A.M. Saw the same Whales again Lowered
at 11 A.M. Struck one & did not get in the
First Iron the Whale Commenced running &
Sounding & run untill 5 P.M. then he Moderat-
ed down some. the Capt. Came & fired two
burn Lances into him the Waste Boat Struck

Lat. 08-10. him at dark he went down & kicked &
Long. 06-40 E. got clear saw no more of him

Remarks Saturday June 19th 1857.

Strong Breere at 10 A.M. Saw a Sperm Whale
Lowered & Struck & got the L. Boat Store
the Waste Boat Struck him & saved
him took him along side

Lat. 08-40 A.
Long. 07-00 E.

Remarks Tuesday July 14th 1857.

These 24 hours Commences with a Moderate Breere heading
to the W. S. W. at 7 A.M. Saw a large
Sperm Whale going quick to the windward
Lowered three Boats & pulled for him
Could not gain on him at 10 A.M. Noon
gave him up & Came onboard took the
Boat up

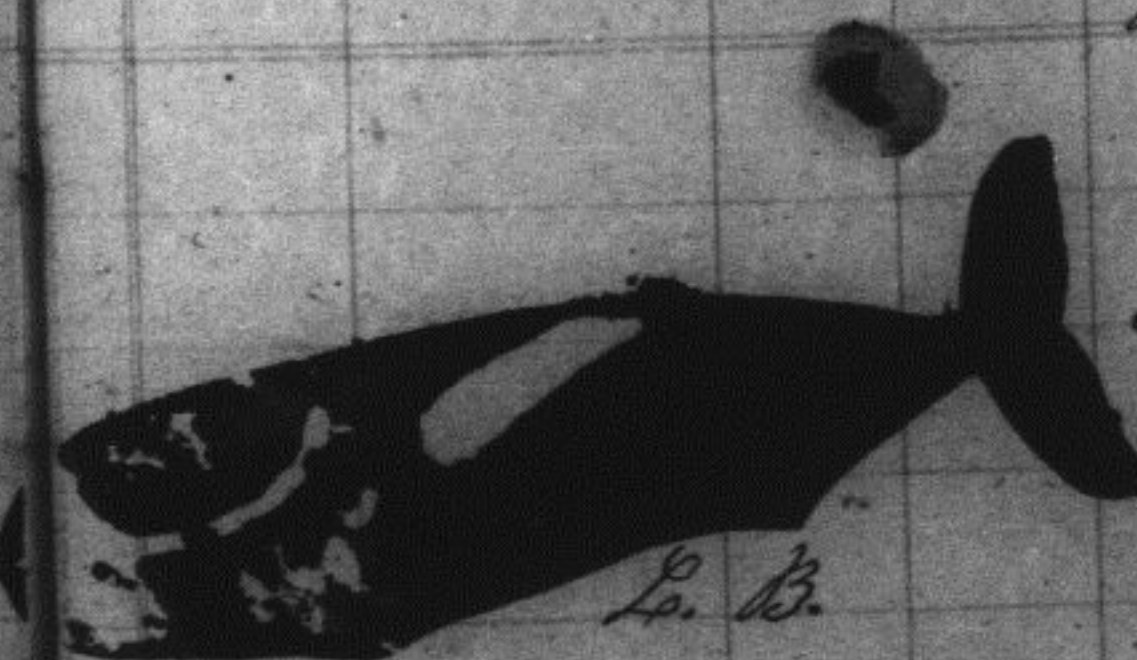
Lat. 09-27 E.

Remarks Friday Aug. 13th 1857.

These 24 hours Commences with a light Breere
Lying at Anchor in Loango Bay in 11
Fathoms of Water Humpbacking the
L. Boat Struck one & hung on to him
about an hour the Iron broke & lost
him

Remarks Saturday 14th 1857.

These 24 hours Commences with a Moderate
Breere at daylight Lowered the Waste
Boat Struck a calf the Iron drewed
after breakfast Lowered 3 Boats the
L. Boat Struck the Con. & Calf at
12 A.M. took the Con along side
