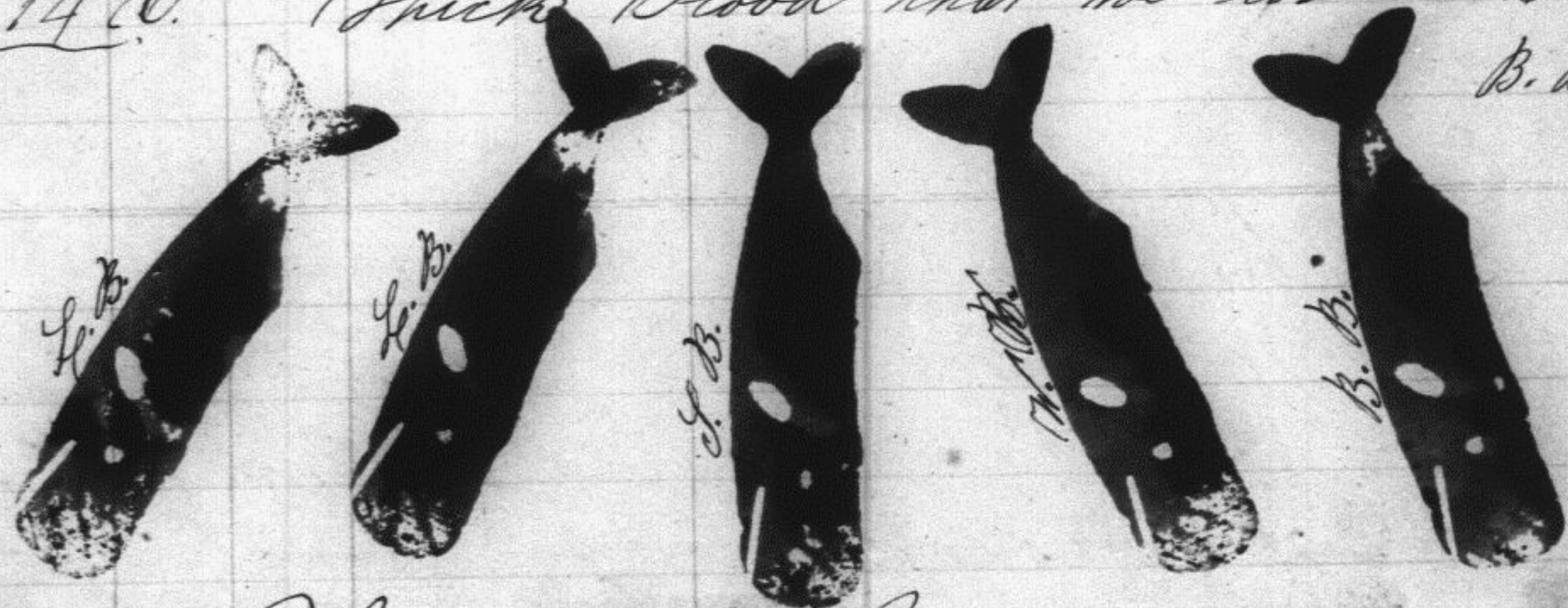


Thursday Oct. 15th 1857.

Thursday Nov. 19th 1857.

at 5 P.M. Saw Sperm Whales Landed
 all 4 boats & pulled for them they were
 on the Weather Beam 3 miles off did
 not see them but once after we Landed

Lat. 11-33 S. At Sundown they were 1/2 mile off going to
 Long. 09-06 W. the Windward. gave them up & came on board

Bark Globe Bound North Jan 28th 1858.

Remarks Thursday Jan. 28th 1858.
 at 5 P.M. & weighed anchor & put to sea
 stood off N. N. W.

Remarks Friday Jan. 29th 1858.
 Then 24 hours. Commenced with a strong
 breeze all sail out steering N. N. W.
 Lat. 14-43 S. at 9 A.M. Spoke the Ann Adamson a
 Long. 07-19 W. Merchant Man

Remarks Saturday Jan. 30th 1858.
 Moderate breeze steering N. N. W. Ann
 Lat. 13-01 S. 2 Merchant Man steering N. W. by N.
 Long. 08-41 W. Bound to the States, supposed

Remarks Sunday Jan. 31st 1858.
 Commenced with a moderate breeze steering
 N. N. W. all sail out at 10 A.M.
 Lat. 11-58 S.
 Long. 10-16 W.
