Remarks Saturday Feb. 20th 1858.

Light air all hands employed in
stowing down oil at 3 P. M. Finished
stowed down 58 Barrels & 18 gallons
saw a merchantman bound to
the Southward

Lat. 04 = 50 N.
Long.

Remarks Sunday Feb. 21st 1858.

Light air all hands employed in stowing down
oil at 3 P. M. Finished stowing down.
Saw a Fin Back Landed one but did
not strike overcast No observation.
at sundown shortened sail

Remarks Monday Feb. 22nd 1858.

Light breeze standing to the Eastward
some squalls of rain at sundown
shortened sail saw plenty of porpoise
& Cow fish.

Lat. 05 = 20 N.
Long. 18 = 51 W.

Remarks Tuesday Feb. 23rd 1858.

Light breeze heading to the N. & Eastward
all sail out saw nothing

Lat. 05 = 04 N.
Long. 18 = 32 W.

Remarks Wednesday Feb. 24th 1858.

Light air from the S. steering N.
Lowered for Black Fish did not get
any saw a sail astern steering N.

Lat. 05 = 21 N.
Long. 19 = 04 W.
