Lat. 23-38 N. S. W. whole ship & headed W. S. W.
Long 43-10 W. Clouds arising Doubled reefed the
Top sails

Remarks Friday April 2nd 1858.

These 24 hours Commences with a strong Breeze
Heading By the Wind W. by S. & her
Course W. S. W. at 4 P. M. Shortened
Lat. 25-38 N. Sail being rugged saw jammers.
Long 44-13 W.

Remarks Saturday April 3rd 1858.

Strong Breeze Under Doubled reefed Top sail
Heading to the Westward at 10 A. M.
Lat. 25-38 N. Turned the reef out. Set the Light
Long 45-14 W. Sails at Sundown took in the Light
Sails

Remarks Sunday April 4th 1858.

Strong Breeze Heading Course S. W. by W.
Middle & Latter part the same
Lat. 26-38 N. So Ends
Long 46-28 W.

Remarks Monday April 5th 1858.

Steering to the S. W. Moderate Breeze
from the S. & Westward all sail out
Lat. 27-19 N.
Long 47-38 W.
