

Free P. S. Bartlett Master for
Hampshire 14th Sept 1878
Saturday September 14th 1878
This day Begins with a fine breeze
From S.W. to N. With rain squalls
Then wind shifted to S.E. then to
S. S.E. at 4 p.m. spoke the Bark
Wanderer and at 6 p.m. up ahead
of the Bite of Fayal and Capt
And Lady went on shore made
Port Wind from S.E. Wind the same

Monday Sept 15th 1878
This day begins with a fresh breeze
from S.E. ship Laying off and on at
Fayal No communication with the shore
see three or four vessels way off
Middle & later part wind the same

Laying off and on at Fayal
Tuesday Sept 16th 1878
This day begins with a strong breeze
from S.E. ship Laying off and on at
Fayal Middle & later part Wind the same
We employed in ship's duty

Wednesday Sept 17th 1878
This day begins with a fresh breeze from
S.W. we exchange boats with the Bark
Wanderer Middle & later part Calm
Ship Laying off and on at Fayal

Free P. S. Bartlett Master for
Hampshire 15th Sept 1878
Thursday Sept 18th 1878
This day Begins with Calm we employed
in letting up Head gear Middle part
light quip from E. by N we steer off to
N.W. 12 Miles South past Rameau
to N.W. spoke Bark Wanderer saw 3 or
4 other sails we employed in setting
Main Top Mast to gallant head stays
to end the day

Friday Sept 19th 1878
This day Begins with a light air from
S ship Cruising off and on of the sea
of Fayal we lift up jib stay Middle
part. light air from the S. then later part
ship under all sail working up to Fayal
at 1.30 p.m. saw the Mail Steamer and
8 or 10 sailing vessels Middle part S
air from S.W. - we are working up to
Fayal later part light air and Calm
with rain to end

Laying off and on at Fayal
Sept Saturday 20th 1878

This day Begins with light air from
South Middle and later part
The same employed ship duty

Sunday Sept 21st 1878
This day Begins Laying off and on
at Fayal with light air and Calm
Middle & later part the same
to end the day
