

Remarks on Board of Ship Nigie Oct
Sunday Sept 28th 1878

This day begins with unsteady breeze
from S.W. to N. course & by E saw on deck
in sight Rain squally fog at
6.30 p.m. wind bore to the Northward
Ship with all sails Middle Part
Wind gains steady from the Eastward
uttered with much rain from the
E. & S. ship on the Wind to Southward
Saw 3 Sails, so Ends

Lat 31.45 N Long 25.22 W

Monday Sept 29th 1878

This day begins with Light airs
and Calmes from S.W. over East
and frequently by Rain squalls
Middle Part breeze from the Westward
course South by E & S. S. & Made
Later Part saw a school of
Porpoise & Black Fish lowered
3 boats did not see the Fish from
the boats so Ends Lat 31.58 N Long 25.10 W

Tuesday Sept 30th 1878

This day begins with light airs and
calm wind from the Eastward saw 2
sails steering to the Northward Middle part
light breeze from S.E. ship to the Wind
on Port tack later part wind the same
ship by the Wind we employed in
ships duty so Ends the days work
Lat 30 30 N Long 24.38 W

Oct 1st Thursday 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from
S. E. by E we are employed in ship duty
Ship by the Wind from S. E. to S. E. later
Part light airs and Calmes we seriously employed
Nothing in sight to day so Ends
Lat 28.55 N Long 24.24

Thursday Oct 2nd 1878

This day begins with light airs and
Calmes Middle & later part the same ship
to the Wind to S. by W. saw one sail
so Ends this day's work Lat 27.34 N Long
22.58 W

Friday Oct 3rd 1878

This day begins with a light breeze
from S. E. ship by the Wind to S. W. we
seriously employed Middle Part a fine
breeze from E course S. by E 1/2 E
ship under sail 3 Royals out later part
fresh breeze from S. W. by S. so Ends
Lat 24.50 N Long 23 W

Saturday Oct 4th 1878

This day begins with fresh breeze from
S. E. course South by E. 1/2 E the atmosphere
smoky the sky is overcast Middle & later
part fine breeze from S. N. E course
S. W. by S we are employed in ship
duty so Ends this days work
Lat 17.40 N
