Ship Neger, on the Passage from

Oct 28th Friday 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. E. by S. ship by the wind at 3 P.M. Exchange signals with a Buoy she was Steaming N. E. Middle Part a fine breeze from S. S. E. last part wind the same we tared down the Head Stays so Ends this days work in

Lat 04.05 S Long 28-48 W

Oct 29th Saturday 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. E. ship by the wind to S. N. Middle Part wind the same later part wind S. E. by S ship by the wind to S. by N we are breaking out the after Haly so this Ends the day

Lat 6.00 S Long 30.30 W

Sunday October 30 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. S. E. ship up to the wind to S. S. N. we finish the after Haly Middle & later part wind the same the weather quite comfortable so Ends this days work

Lat 7.35 S Long 35.50 W

Monday Oct 31 1887

This day begins with a lite breeze from S. S. E. ship by the wind to S. N. saw a shoal of porpois and cow fish and Fin back Whale they reported from Mast Head for sperm whale Middle part we employed in fitting up the Blubber Room so Ends this days work

In Lat 9.05 S Long 31.00 W

Nov 1st Sunday 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. E. by S. ship by the wind we finish the after Haly Middle & later part wind the same the weather quite cloudy to day so Ends the days work Lat 73.35 S Long 30.50 W

Nov 2nd Saturday 1878

This day begins with a breeze from S. S. E ship by the wind to S. N. saw a shoal of Porpois and Cow fish and and Fin back Whale so Ends the days work

Tuesday Nov 4th 1878

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. S. E. ship by the wind to the S. W. we employed in breaking and loopering the Cark in Between decks Middle Part wind from S. E. latter part we employed fitting the Between deck saw six or seven vessels to day so Ends this days work

In Lat 11-4 S Long 31-30 W

Nov 5th Wednesday 1878

This day begins with a lite breeze from S. E ship by the wind to S. by W. we seriously be employed in ship duty Middle part breeze from S. E. to E. S. & course South by East later part lite breeze from S. E. the weather very clear and temperature very mild this has been a very fine day we have been loopering our bread and flour in the hold so Ends this day

Lat 14-21 S Long 31-22 W
