Ship Niger on passage from Africa to St Helena

August 18th 1879
This day begins with Lite breeze from S
Ship by the Wind to W. S. W. we are
employed in ships duty Middle part
Wind very lite latter Part Wind veered to S. E.
So Ends Lat 8:10 S. Long 7.55 E

August 21st 1879
This day begins with a Lite Breeze
from S. W. by S. at 2.30 p.m. wind shift
to W. we are employed in ships duty
Middle part Wind lite and from S. W.
latter Part Wind the same we are employed
in ships duty Lat 8.10 S. Long 7.14 E

August 22nd 1879
This day begins with Lite air from S. W.
at 6 P.M. Wind veered to S. S. W. Ship
on the Wind under all sails Middle part
a Fine Breeze for awhile latter Part Lite
Breeze from S. by W. So ends this day
Lat 8.30 S. Long 6.32 E

August 23rd 1879
This day begins with Lite air from
S by W. Ship under all sail by the
Wind on Port tack Saw a School of
Black fish Middle part Wind from
W. S. W. Wore ship to the S. on Starboard
Tack at 6 A.M. Wore ship to W by S
on Port tack Wind from S. S. W.
we simply in ships duty So Ends
Lat 8.55 S Long 5.50 E

August 24th 1879
This day begins with Lite Breeze from S by W
Ship by the Wind on Port tack Middle
part Lite Breeze S. W. to S. W. by S. latter
Part Wind the same So Ends Lat 7.10 S. Long 4.55 E

August 25th 1879
This day begins with Lite Breeze from S. W.
by S. Ship by the Wind to W. by S. Saw one
Fin Back Whale and a School of porpoise
Middle part a Strong Breeze from S by E
With Squalls latter part Strong Breeze
from S. Saw 2 or 3 Fin Back Whales
and one Hump Back Whale
So Ends this day in Lat 10.05 S Long 3.58 E

August 26th 1879
This day begins with a Strong Breeze
from S. by E. Ship by the Wind at
W. S. W. Saw Hump Back Whales
Middle part Strong Breeze from
S. by E latter Part Wind the same
Nothing in sight sight ship under all
sail So Ends this day Lat 10.40 S Long 3.00 E

August 27th 1879
This day begins with a Strong Breeze from
S. to S by E Ship by the Wind to W. S. W. Ship
under all sails we are employed in ships duty
Middle part a Fine Breeze from S. by E
latter part Wind S. by E to S. S. E. Ship by the
Wind to S. W. So Ends Lat 11.52 S Long 1.45 E
