

Remarks On Board of Ship *Argo* of
making passage from Kibanda to St Helena

August 27th 1879

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. to S. by E. Ship under all sail by the wind to S. by W. We are employed in ship's duty middle part a fine breeze from S. by E. course S. by W. by latter part wind the same nothing in sight
So ends this day in Lat 12-53 00-03 B

August 28th 1879

This day begins with lite and baffling wind from S. to S. by W. We are employed in ship's duty middle & latter parts wind lite and baffling from S. to S. by E. course W. by S.
So ends this day Lat 13-45 S Long 2-25 W

August 30th 1879

This day begins with the lite airs from S. by E. course W. by S. Middle part a fine breeze from S. by W. course W. by latter part wind the same so ends Lat 14-40 S Long 1-42 W

August 31st 1879

This day begins with lite breeze from S. by E. course W. by S. saw some Sulphur bottom and our course at 6 p.m. W 1/2 S. Middle part wind the same latter part wind the same course W. by N. so ends this day at Lat 15-30 S Long 4-30 W

New Bedford Mass Thomas A. Hallett Master 37
making passage from Kibanda to St Helena

Sept 1st 1879

This day begins with a fine breeze from S. by E. to S. by W. course W. saw two or three fine back whales middle part sighted the land at 11-50 A.M. came to anchor in the harbor of St Helena so ends this Cruise 4 months out with 475 sperm oil and all well

Sept 2nd 1879

off St Helena employed in washing ship and getting the rest of the topsails sheeted so ends

Sept 3rd 1879

employed in getting out shooks & heels so ends

Sept 4th 1879

employed in setting up shooks

Sept 5th 1879

we are employed in setting up shooks and taking in water

Sept 6th 1879

we are employed in setting up shooks

Sept 7th 1879

we have let the Starboard water for a Run

Sept 8th 1879

we are setting up shooks and taking in water

Sept 9th 1879

we have finally setting up shooks we have sent some packages on shore and sold two barrels of Rite whale oil
