April 4th 1880

Sunday, In Port Starboard Hatch
on a Run ashore

In Port we are employed in setting
up the Rigging

April 7th 1880

We are employed in Ships duty
Setting off Shocks & Shocks Heads

April 8th we are setting up shocks

April 9th

We commence to put our oil on
Board the Bark Michel Merte

New Bedford Capt Thomas C Hallett 191
April 10th 1880 at St Helena ^{miles}

We are shipping oil on the Bark

April 11th we are still shipping oil on
the Bark

April 12th

We are still shipping oil

April 13th We are still shipping oil

April 14th We are stowing the
Main Hold with water

April 15th

We are Breaking out the Fore
Hold and setting up Shocks

April 16th 1880

We are employed shipping oil and
are getting off Shocks the weather is
squally at 1 P.M. We are dragging
our anchor and dragging down
on and English Man of War
we carried away our flying jib
boom

April 17th

We are setting up Shocks and stowing
the Hold

April 18th Starboard Hatch on a Run

April 19th We are setting up Shocks and
Running in salt water

April 20th setting up Shocks and

atching up our Copper

April 21st We are setting up Shocks and
filling Baskets with salt water
