 Received 92 barrels of Herron & of Shad stored the greater part of them

10th Jan 1796 Received 2 Hogs Pork
 11th Jan 1796 Received some Cabin Stoves and furniture Employed in sundries
 12th Jan 1796 Nothing remarkable
 13th Jan 1796 Wind N.W. with thin clear Employed in mending again
 trying sail scraping & mending fore topmast & mending repairing
 the sails at 3 P.M. sent up fore top gallant mast

14th Jan 1796 This day have moderate breeze from the north E. and
 clear weather received 20 barrels of Herron on board
 Employed in sundries duties of the Dept

15th Jan 1796 Employed in taking 9 barrels of Herron and
 4 of Shad

16th Jan 1796 Employed this day
 in getting
 a plan for Carr

17th Jan 1796 Employed in sundry duties
 of the Dept at 12 this day Gilbert
 Ford Quitted work at 1 P.M.
 the Lighter came alongside
 with 35 barrels of Herron and
 12 barrels empty and a quantity
 of Staves

18th Jan 1796 Nothing from this day

19th Jan 1796 Nothing remarkable this day
 20th Jan 1796 Had the Schooner Capt. Jerry
 to come along side & laden a
 Lighter from up the river 7 barrels
 of fish 6 of Herron of Shad and some
 Hoops and Staves Received some boards
 Capt. Jerry and 7 Apron Poles

21st Jan 1796 All hands Employed in Packing & Pickling of Herron on
 board the Schooner Capt. Jerry. Struck down
 and wadded 108 barrels

Wednesday 22nd Jan
 Begins with light wind from the N.W. had some small
 showers of struck down 153 barrels of fish from on board
 Capt. Jerry took 2 Casks of shad on board and
 a boat load of Staves

Thursday 23rd Jan
 Begins light air from southward and good weather
 at 4 P.M. small showers of rain from N.W. and
 Staved down 52 barrels of Herron

Friday 24th Jan
 Begins light southerly breeze at day
 light was performed that one of our deckmen was
 headed up and staved down the remainder of our
 fish from Capt. Jerry 34 of Herron and 5 barrels
 of Pickled Salmon took the Staves from
 the deck

Saturday 25th Jan
 Begins with N.W. wind Employed in taking up water
 on board took five Hoops and Staved down
 the remainder of the Staves of Deck washed Deck
 down

Sunday 26th Jan
 Begins moderate N.W. wind and fine weather
 Nothing remarkable this day

Monday 27th Jan
 Begins fine breeze from the northward at board
 got ready for to go down took in three barrels of shad
 one barrel of oil & barrels of red Herron
 dropped down of far ship broke thru the wind headed
 and came to the boat went to Summersett and
 fetched 4 barrels of beef and 9 of bread bars

Tuesday 28th Jan
 This day Received the Lighter from the Dard
 Brought with 2 Casks of salt & few boxes of
 Herron
