

Transactions on Saturday 26 October 1793
Begins Moderate breezes from the S.W. and Cloudy
Employed in Discharging our oil Ends

Transactions on Sunday 27 October 1793
Begins Moderate W.M. winds and Cloudy
 Latter Part Light E. winds and the weather
 Cloudy and the air clear Ends

Transactions on Monday 28 October 1793
Begins a brisk wind from the N.E. and
 Cloudy some frost at 8. A.M. soon after
 ed but a very small quantity of it at 10 fin-
 ished getting out the remainder of our
 oil and stored it the People went on shore
 Ends

Transactions on Tuesday 29 October
Begins a brisk wind from the N.E.
 and Cloudy Employed in balling our
 defect off for anchored on to ball within us

Transactions on Wednesday 30 October 1793
Begins a brisk wind from the N.E. and Cloudy
 at 2. P.M. made the defect fast and the People
 took their Liberty and went on shore
 Latter Part winds more moderate and the
 weather Cloudy the People took their Liberty
 Bedding out of the defect Ends ^{Wind immediately on}
 the 31st Monday
