

Transactions on Saturday 19 October 1793

Begins a moderate wind from ESE & to the southward at 6 Enclining to the SW stood on with the Larboard Tacks on board at 8 P.M. Tacked and stood in Towards Long Island for to come too anchor at 11 Came too in 15 fathoms of water & breast of gill Towed Latter Part begins calm at 2 P.M. had a light breeze from SE and Pleasant weather & weighed our anchor Made all sail set stearing sails fore and aft and several vessels Paying up and down the Sound Ends

Transactions on Sunday 20 October 1793

Begins a moderate breeze from SSE at 9 AM standing on bore South still standing up Sound in company with several small vessels at 5 P.M. Passed by the Dutch ship ping stones at 5:15 Came up with frogs Point the light made a long against us and the wind leading us as which obliged us to come too with the small anchor at 7 went on shore with the boat and got some milk at 8 had a squall from the W at 9 More moderate returned on board Much Part & Latter Part winds brisk at 9 P.M. weighed anchor & began to beat down at 10 AM took on board and the gate Pilot Ends

Transactions on Monday 21 October 1793

Begins kind ~~SE~~ W at 11 P.M. Passed through bell gate and Backed and fell through the Sound at 3 P.M. Came to anchor in the shoals of Long York the Capt. Denton shore

Latter Part the weather clear at 8 A.M. Weight and haled in a long side of Mores in half Employed in on bedding out sails and stowing of them on bent the Cables and Coiled them down

Transactions on Tuesday 22 October 1793

Begins Pleasant weather wind N.W. Employed in Discharging our Empty Cask & Shacks and making clear for our oil

Transactions on Wednesday 23 October 1793

Begins a moderate & pretty wind and clear weather at 7 A.M. Began to discharge our oil and Provisions the wind in evening at 4 P.M. reached the shore the Stone Ends

Transactions on Thursday 24 October 1793

Begins Brisk N.W. winds and clear weather Much Part Light SE winds and clear Latter Part had the greatest Part of the crew to go on shore without Liberty and did not come to hoist the oil out Discharged nothing this day

Transactions on Friday 25 October 1793

Begins Moderate breeze from the SW and Pleasant weather at 6 A.M. Began to hoist out oil hired a three Men in the team of the tide that run away and saw Bonnell which is on shore at 6 P.M. Reached the shore in the Stone Ends in good weather
