

Transactions on Friday 27 September 1793
 Begins brisk gales from the North and rain attended
 middle Part Unequally Latter Part more variable
 at 2 P.M. the wind S.W. at 6 P.M. at 1 P.M. sent
 the boat on shore to fetch the Capt & Pilot to carry
 the Ship round into wind port at 7 the boat returned
 with the Capt & Pilot hoed up our top of anchor
 & set our top sails weighed the other anchor and made
 all standing sail fast to the Capmains & southward of tack
 of land sent up top gallant masts at the rigging up sent up
 top gallant yards fore & aft set the sails at 11 Passed by the
 Light house at 12 took in top gallant sails and stay sail. got
 Passed round the North End of ~~the~~ fort of land run down
 within that and the town came too in 3. fathoms of water
 Heaved with our two small anchors the Pilot and Capt
 went on shore Ends

Transactions on Saturday 28 September 1793

Begins a Pleasant breeze from the S.W. and fine Pleasant
 weather at 2 P.M. got up our steering sails to try had the
 tick draters to come on board Employed in sanding the
 of the vessel at 6 P.M. had some fresh meat & soap come on
 board put the sails down Latter Part winds variable at 8.

P.M. the wind at S.W. at 10 P.M. the Sella & one of the
 Watchman, went on shore to join the Probitt Ends
 fine Pleasant weather

Transactions on Sunday Sep 29 1793

Begins a fine breeze from S.W. and Pleasant weather
 at 2 P.M. the Ship haled of in the bores at 4 the wind
 changed to the Southward Latter Part began light
 Air and fog attended at 10 Calm at 11 small breeze
 from the Southward Ends 173

Sunday Sept 29

Transactions on Monday 30 September 1793 / 1793

Begins light winds from south and Pleasant weather
 at 1 P.M. the Prop. went on shore on Liberty at 6 returned
 on board Latter Part light winds and Pleasant weather
 at 2 P.M. the Ship William weighed and went to the
 Point at 7 had the ferry boat to come alongside with the
 Anchors that in. Left on the other side of Connet at 7 took
 the anchors on the bough and began to paint the vessel
 and Capins Ends fine Pleasant weather

Transactions on Tuesday October 1 1793

Begins fine Pleasant breeze from the Southward at 2 P.M.
 the boat went on shore for some soap at 2 returned on board
 Latter Part winds from S.W. & Cloudy at 12 sent the
 boat on shore for fresh meat at 3 returned at 9 sent the boat
 on shore for fresh water at 11 P.M. a large ship came
 in and anchored to the Point Employed in painting
