

Set the main top gallant sail *Set down by the other ship*

Transactions on Sunday 13 July 1793

Begin Light breeze at 1 P.M. Cam. 100 about a league to windward of the Point in 15 fathoms of water. Set 2 Part Light breezes from the S. and Cam. to the Southward at 6 P.M. drew off with our two boats and nothing more than humpbacks returned on board. End

Transactions on Sunday 14 July 1793

Begin Light southerly breeze. Capt. & Main Cam. down bay with Part attended with fagg. Set 2 Part winds from the Eastward broke many ships with Capt. Briggs at 6 P.M. broke up our fore boat to heave out the half of a nd bale we got in Company and several hump backs the Capt. went off and struck one which Capt. reports two boats upset and killed but had but to sink. But both had up and began to tow at 11 P.M. took her along.

Transaction on Monday 15 July 1793

Begin Light Air from the Eastward at 2 P.M. worked on and began to Cat at 5 finished with Part fagg. Set 2 Part. Clear weather wind at 6 P.M. the Capt. went on shore fishing began to clear fagg out holes and get up and I spoke bottom at 11 finished went on boat on shore off sand when returned took the fagg out and the steamer got all clear but the trade a head to go out. End

Transactions on Tuesday 16 July 1793

Begin Light Air from the West too short and weighed our anchor to go to sea bound to Rhode Island in Company Capt. & Main Capt. Rosson Capt. Briggs at 2 P.M. had the wind to moderate and shift round to the Northward and set in thick with fagg. Cloud up our sails Cam. to in 15 fathoms of water with the stream anchor began to Cat very precisely the Part being at 11 P.M. 3 Miles distant. Later Part Moderate weather at 6 P.M. had a Light breeze from South too short and weighed. Haul sail of the Part the Part Stead at 11 and several humpbacks at 11 the Part Part bore 12 1/2 S. 1/2 E. 3 Leagues from which took my departure being in a little 1/2 30 S. 1/2 E. 12 1/2 East
