

Transactions on Wednesday 1st May 1793

Begins a light southerly wind at 4 P.M. finished gunnening the longboat down the waist boat went a fishing and the Captⁿ went caught several large fish but very few small ones at 6 the boat returned had 3 sheep came on board from the governor
 Latter Part Moderate breezes and variable at 4 P.M. the Captⁿ went a fishing caught but few Employed in cutting one of our fore topsails that is to large so ends

Transactions on Thursday 2nd May 1793

Begins a moderate southerly wind at 1 P.M. the boat went on shore to get some food for the sheep at 3 returned on board at 7 P.M. had it foggy thick Part fresh breezes and thick weather Latter Part the wind more moderate and the weather more clear at 7 P.M. had the fog to clear had the Captⁿ of the other ships to come on board to see Employed in fitting the fore topsail End

Transactions on Friday 3rd May 1793

Begins a moderate southerly wind and gradually increasing at 2 P.M. the Captⁿ gardner Captⁿ ray Captⁿ Briggs all weighed and went out at 3 P.M. the Captⁿ went on shore to the governor at 5 the boat returned sent the waist boat on shore a fishing at 8 P.M. the boat returned with a half barrel of fish took the boat a pander one of the quarter boats Latter Part moderate southerly wind and clear weather at 7 P.M. saw the table land at 8 went out to firing and after eggs got but very few at 11 the boat returned on board from the fore topsail on both them that was bent and bent the other one so ends

Transactions on Saturday 4 May 1793

Begins a light southerly wind and clear weather at 1 P.M. sent the waist boat and crew on shore after the Captⁿ sent the waist boat and a crew on shore after bushes for the sheep at 3 the boat returned with the bushes at 5 P.M. the boat returned sent the waist boat on shore a fishing at 10 P.M. returned with several buckets full of fish Latter Part the wind from the Eastward and gradually hauling to the Southward at 7 P.M. sent the waist boat a fishing after the Captⁿ and the spare boat on shore after fresh bushes at 9 both boats returned had the wind from the Eastward from the starboard boat and another took the spare boat up and put her over the stern sent the Main top of tent. at 11 the Captⁿ went on shore a shooting at 11 returned wind NW

Transactions on Sunday 5 May 1793

Begins calm went after cofters for shore caught as many as the Captⁿ thought proper would keep at 4 returned on board at 8 P.M. the Captⁿ went on shore a ranging with the star board boat at 12 returned with very few fish Latter Part the winds light and flattering at 7 calm bore the anchor up and clear it set it go again sent one boat on shore after two sheep and one goat went with the other boat a shooting on the shore at 11 the boat returned on board with the two sheep and one goat at 11 the other boat returned on board so ends
