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Friday 12 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from the South and some squally at 3 P.M. saw a large sperm whale board the boats and the starboard boat got fast and the crew came out middle part lite winds from the South and East latter part strong from the South and Eastward at midday spoke the Brig hopaton of siph Capt Perry cutting a whale oil 75 lb

Saturday 13 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the South and Eastward saw hoppers middle part strong winds from the South and Eastward latter part the same saw one sail standing to North so ends
Lat 36° 53' N Long 42° 10' W

Sunday 14 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the South and Eastward at 6 P.M. spoke the Schooner Oxford Capt Snow middle part strong wind from the South latter part the same
Lat 36° 56' N Long 41° 38' W

Monday 15 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the South two sails in site middle part strong winds from South and Eastward and pleasant latter part the same two sails in site
Lat 36° 06' N Long 42° 44' W

Tuesday 16 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from the South and Eastward and pleasant with middle part Lite winds from the South and pleasant latter part the same two sails in site to day so ends these 24 hours
Lat 35° 57' N Long 42° 46' W

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Wednesday 17 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from the Eastward and pleasant 9 o'clock the Bark union of madagascar Capt Sexton middle part Lite winds from the Eastward latter part the same saw porpoises to day
Lat 36° 08' N Long 42° 57' W

Thursday 18 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the Eastward and pleasant one sail in site middle part Lite winds from the Eastward latter part Lite winds from the North and Westward one sail in site saw porpoises so ends
Lat 35° 57' N Long 42° 55' W

Friday 19 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the North and Westward one sail in site today at 7 P.M. spoke the Brig march of madagascar Capt Lewis middle part Lite winds from the Westward latter part Lite winds squally and aging with two sails in site today
Lat 35° 40' N Long 42° 45' W

Saturday 20 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the North and Westward two sails in site middle part Lite winds from the Eastward latter part the winds from the South and pleasant two sails in site to day so ends these 24 hours
Lat 35° 36' N Long 42° 06' W

Sunday 21 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the South and at 4 P.M. the wind board to the North one sail in site middle part Lite winds from the North and pleasant latter part the winds from the South and pleasant with two sails to day so ends these 24 hours
Lat 35° 50' N Long 41° 45' W
