fine weather saw black fish. So Ends the 24

Monday 26 these 24 hours Commences with gentle winds
from the South and Eastward and pleasant
middle part lite winds from the Eastward
latter part lite winds and Calms so Ends
Lat 36° 59' N Long 36° 48' W

Tuesday 27 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds
from the Eastward nothing in site to
day middle part lite winds from the East
and pleasant latter part the same saw 2 sails
Lat 36° 46' N Long 36° 02' W

Wednesday 28 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds
from the South and Eastward two sails
in site day middle part lite winds from
the Eastward latter part the same so Ends
Lat 36° 55' N Long 35° 51' W

Thursday 29 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds
from the Eastward - three sails in site
middle part strong winds from the East
latter part strong winds from the South and
aged at 6 a.m. saw sperm whales and
the boats did not get fast

Friday 30 these 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from middle part strong winds from
the westward and a heavy swell from the
North at 8 a.m. spoke the Bark P. Boyd
Lat 36° 33' N Long 36° 26' W

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August 31 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
the North and westward and a heavy swell on
at 6 p.m. spoke the Schooner King Fisher of Portland
Capt. Sanborn middle part lite winds from the
North and a heavy swell latter part the same
Lat 36° 48' N Long 35° 46' W

September 1 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from
the North and pleasant one sail in site to day
middle part lite winds from the South and westward
latter part the same one sail in site to day
Lat 36° 35' N Long 36° 40' W

Monday 2 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from
the South and westward and pleasant weather in
site middle part lite winds from the westward
a heavy swell from the North latter part the same
nothing in site to day so Ends these 24 hours
Lat 36° 35' N Long 36° 35' W

Tuesday 3 these 24 hours Commences with strong with lite
winds from the westward and a heavy swell
in the day middle part strong winds from the west
and some squally latter part the same saw one
sail to day so Ends these 24 hours
Lat 36° 46' N Long 35° 51' W

Wednesday 4 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
the westward middle part strong winds from
the North and some squally latter part
the same nothing in site to day so Ends
Lat 36° 57' N Long 36° 54' W

Thursday 5 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
the North and pleasant weather nothing in site to day
middle part lite winds from the North and
pleasant latter part the same nothing in site
Lat 36° 53' N Long 38° 38' W
