Sunday 6 these 24 hours Commences with light from the South and pleasant weather saw a number of sail bound to the Eastward middle part strong winds from the Westward and cloudy latter part the same saw two sails today

Monday 7 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and squally saw one sail middle part light winds from the North and Eastward and pleasant weather with nothing in site
Lat 36.47 N Long 34.42 W

Tuesday 8 these 24 hours Commences with light winds from the North and Eastward and pleasant weather with nothing in site middle part light winds from the Eastward and pleasant weather latter part the winds from all round the Compass so Ends there

Saturday 12 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the South and Westward and rugged one sail in site at 7 1/2 o'clock had a very blow lost the mast Boat fore Topmast started fore sail split the main Top sail at 12 o'clock it made latter part strong winds from the North and rugged with nothing in site to Day & Ends there

Sunday 13 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and rugged weather with nothing in site middle part strong winds from the North and rugged latter part the same with nothing in site
Lat 38.10 N Long 29.50 W

Monday 14 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and squally one sail in site middle part strong winds from the North and Eastward at 6 am saw Bazar being lost latter part strong winds from the North and Eastward and rugged off to the west of Bazar so Ends there
Lat 38.34 N Long 28.06 W

Tuesday 15 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and Eastward and rugged at 5.30 PM saw sperm whales and heard the boats and got one at 8 PM got him along side middle part strong winds from the North at 6 am Commenced putting off to the west of Bazar so Ends there 24 hours
