16 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the Eastward and raining wet and thick middle part the winds all round the compass latter part the winds from the S.W. and thick and raining saw a schooner so ends the

Sunday

17 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the North and Eastward one schooner in sight middle part strong winds from the North and Westward thunder lightning and rain and hail
Lat 37. 18 N Long 68. 41 W

Monday

18 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and Westward and squally thunder lightning and hail saw two sails to day Barometer middle part strong winds and squally with latter part the same saw five sails to day
Lat 37. 46 N Long 68. 23 W

Tuesday

19 these 24 hours Commences with strong gale from the North West and surged with wet so squally middle part the winds hauled to the Eastward latter part blowing a heavy gale from the North East and a heavy fog on so ends
Lat 38. 30 N Long 68. 20 W

Wednesday

20 these 24 hours Commences with a strong gale from the S.W. and raining hard middle part the same latter part blowing but not much rain so ends the 24 hours
Lat 38. 04 N Long 70. 01 W

Thursday

21 these 24 hours Commences with a strong gale from the S.W. and very sea on middle part strong winds from the North and Westward and very rugged with saw one sail to day ends
Lat 37. 53 N Long 70. 12 W

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Monday

22 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the North and Westward some squally with in sight middle part strong winds from the North and West latter part Lite winds from the North and West
Lat 37. 31 N Long 70. 08 W

Tuesday

23 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the North and Westward one schooner in sight to day middle part Lite winds from the North and West latter part Lite winds from the South and Westward and pleasant with one schooner of sails in sight
Lat 37. 52 N Long 68. 30 W

Wednesday

24 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the South and Westward and pleasant middle part strong winds from the South and Westward latter part the same saw one ship to day so ends
Lat 40. 12 N Long 71. 30 W

Thursday

25 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the South and Westward at 4 P.M. sounded got 35 fathoms water
