

Document of George [unclear] on board Ship [unclear]

Thursday July 4th 1844
Fresh gales and heavy swell from the S.W. lowered
times for whales without success Employed in stow-
ing down 3 souls in sight

Friday July 5

First part calm lowered for whales 3 times without
success finished stowing down 4 Ships in sight
later heavy thick fog and a gale of wind from the W.S.W.

Saturday July 6

A heavy gale from the W.S.W. laying to under storm
sails at 4 P.M. pitched away the fly jib boom

Sunday July 7

First part heavy gales from the Westward
at 5 P.M. took in the Mainst. mast to repair
at 1 P.M. raised Whales the bow boat fastened
and started at 3 P.M. lowered again the larboard
boat lowered and started at 4 P.M. from Hong side
Lat 55° 36' N Long 147° 06' W

Monday July 8

at 4 P.M. called at anchor to getting ready
for cutting at 6 commenced cutting at 11 P.M. finished
3 souls in sight at 3 P.M. commenced trying

Tuesday July 9

Drizzle wind from the North-east employed in trying
at 10 P.M. lowered for Whales the Mainst. mast went
on board and mised got nothing

of Fair Haven Cruising on the West for Whales

Wednesday July 10 1844

light winds and calm lowered for Whales 4 times
of times without success spoke the brig of Fair Haven
13 months out 1200 lbs saw the Ballast of New Bedford
10 months out 800. boarded the Delfos of Fishery
10 months out 1500

Thursday July 11

light winds from the Eastward at 11 P.M. lowered
for Whales without success at 10 P.M. finished trying
at 4 P.M. lowered again worst boat started and finished

Friday July 12

Fresh gales from the Eastward lowered for Whales
the Worst boat went on and struck the bow boat
went on and struck and got her boat cut in two
the worst boat cut stowed down 3 lbs of oil

Saturday July 13

light winds from the Eastward stowed down 40 lbs
of oil at 7 P.M. the worst boat struck a whale at dark
cut from them and left him spouting thin blood

Sunday July 14

light winds from the Eastward lowered 4 miles
of times for Whales without success

Monday July 15

Fresh gales from the Northward lowered for a dead
Whale but made no good for any good
Saw the triche of New Bedford
