Sunday June 10 1843

Pleasant weather and light winds cruising off the Navigators at noon Boatwells bearing South dit 5 m

Monday June 11

Pleasant weather cruising off the Island of Pootowah
No nothing in sight

Tuesday June 12

Moderate trades cruising off the Navigators employ
ed in tarring down rigging forward

Wednesday June 13

Fresh trades steering by the wind to the N E Nothing
in sight employment in tacking July Lat 10 45 South Long 170 00 East

Thursday June 14

Fresh trades steering on different tacks Nothing in sight
Lat 10 51 Long 170 53 East

Friday June 15

More or less strong winds from the Eastward cruising
under short sail Lat 13 00 South Long 171 32 East

Saturday June 16

Strong winds from the Eastward at daylight
to saw the Island of Survey at 9 AM kept off
and ran down past the Island the light shined in
out to the reef but did not land at sunset kept
about West for the Frejers

Sunday June 17

Strong winds with rain steering West

Ship Theron of Fair Haven Cruising off the Frejers

Fresh winds from the Eastward steering West under
all sail employed in setting up the rigging
