Tuesday May 16

Fresh gales, cruising off tootroil-fab at 9.15
found the Saint boat and took her up
Sail in sight. Boiled out our blubber

Wednesday May 17

Fresh gales from the Eastward cruising off
tootroil-fab

Thursday May 18

Strong trades at 11 last night kept off and ran
down to the seaward of at daylight off the
weather end of Opole at 11.5 took off 1 white
man from Opole to trade for 10 pounds

Friday May 19

Fresh trades at daylight kept for in for the
land at 2 pm. Let go anchor at the Pere harbor
at the Island of Opole

Saturday May 20

Fine weather employed in washing the ships and
blackening the bars and varnishing the waist

Sunday May 21

Fine weather the Starboard watch went on shore
on liberty for 24 hours

Monday May 22

Fine weather got off 11 raft of water to day
the starboard watch went on shore on
liberty for the night got off some Hogs and

board Ship Sharon of Port Haven

Tuesday May 23

Fine weather the watch came on board at 11.5
stowed down our water and took the birds on shore
again the starboard watch went on shore for the night

Wednesday May 24

Fine weather got off 1 raft of water and stowed
away also got off some Hogs and skins the
starboard watch went on shore on liberty for the night

Thursday May 25

Fine weather employed in getting of recruits
on Lyons Hogs, Diamonds, Pine Apples &c
starboard on shore on liberty for the night

Friday May 26

Fine weather got off 4 boatloads of wood
and stowed it away took the starboard and waist
boats on shore to paint getting off Hogs and skins
1 watch on liberty for the night
Shipped 3 hands

Saturday May 27

got off 1 boatload of wood 1 watch on liberty
for 24 hours Boiled the 2 boats

Sunday May 28

There was a heavy squally of rain 1 watch on
shore on liberty for 24 hours

Monday May 29

Fine weather the Capt went down to the Cannoe
to day 1 watch went on shore on liberty
