Moderate winds from the S & steering  
N & B & took in new Foretop sail to day

Tuesday April 18  
Light winds from the S & steering by the wind  
under all sail nothing in sight at 4 PM got  
out the bow boat

Wednesday April 19  
Moderate winds from the N & W to West S & W  
steering by the wind and North

Thursday April 20  
A fresh breeze from the Southward steering  
North under all sail

Friday April 21  
Moderate gales from the Southward steering  
North under all sail

Saturday April 22  
Light winds from the Eastward and calm  
steering S & under employed in taring down  
rigging

Sunday April 23  
Light winds from the Eastward steering North  
at 1 PM raised spruce Whaler and lowered  
4 boats for them the Starboard Mast and  
Bow boats fastened the Mast and Starboard  
hides and raised the Bow boats Iron broke  
took them along side at 4 1/2 PM and cut  
one of them in 2
