Light winds from the Eastward steering by the wind
Saw a plenty of Finbacks and Porpoises
Lat by Obs 00:15 South Long by Chro 174:23 East

Sunday August 21

Light winds from the Eastward and Pleasant
weather Saw Finbacks Lat 00:20 South Long 164:20

Monday August 22

Light winds from the ESE steering by the wind
Saw Killers, Finbacks and Porpoises
Lat by Obs 02:13 North Long by Chro 164:30 so Ends

Tuesday August 23

These 24 hours moderate breezes from the ESE
to NE by N steering by the wind, Saw Porpoises
Lat by Obs 00:02 South Long by Chro 164:20

Wednesday August 24

Light winds from the Eastward steering by the
wind tacked Ship once Caught a Porpoise and killed it
Lat by Obs 00:34 S Long by Chro 164:22 East

Thursday August 25

Light winds from the Eastward steering by
the wind Nothing in sight Lat 00:13 S Long 164:40

Friday August 26

Light winds from the Eastward steering by the wind
Saw Porpoises and Finbacks Lat

in sight Lat by Obs 02:34 S Long by Chro 165:05 so Ends

Tuesday August 30

Light winds from the Southward steering ESE and by
wind Lat by Obs 01:18 South Long 166:18 East so Ends

Wednesday August 31

Moderate breezes from the Southward to West steering by
E by N Lat 01:45 S Long 167:00 East so Ends

Thursday September 1

Light winds from the NE steering by the wind heading
ESE at 6 1/2 AM the Captain came on deck when 1 of the
Men ^{Jack Baker} _(see 1953) came and brought George Berbeck's
(A Coloured man) aft containing a small piece of
Pork the Captain ordered him to set it on the hen box
the Captain ordered the Steward to pass up his rope
which was a piece of Whales line about 5 feet long
with a knot in 1 end and the other Whipped with
11 turns he then began to curse and swear at
Berbeck, who was oiling a Brass cannon that stood
