

Journal of Whaling Voyage Kept on board Ship

Wednesday June 29<sup>th</sup> 1842  
These 24 hours Pleasant breeze from the East at sunrise kept her off West at 4 PM raised Sperm Whales and put off after them the barbed boat struck and crew at sunset took up the boat Lat by Obs 18 S Long by Obs 16 S 15 W

Thursday June 30  
These 24 hours light winds from the East cruising spoke the Barque Lagrange of Fair Haven Capt Stetson 12 1/2 months out 400 lbs of Sperm Oil Lat 13 S Long 16 S 15 W

Friday July 1  
Light winds from the Eastward at sunrise kept her off from N to W at 1 PM raised Pleasant Island and ran down to it and the Canoes came off to trade the Lagrange in sight

Saturday July 2  
Light winds from the Eastward cruising off Pleasant Island some Canoes came off to trade at 1 PM kept her off West 2 Sails in sight

Sunday July 3  
A stiff breeze from the Eastward steering by the wind Pleasant Island in sight bearing East 2 Sails in sight

Monday July 4  
Light winds from the Eastward cruising by the wind Pleasant Island in sight

Whaler of Fair Haven Capt Harris cruising on the line

Tuesday July 5<sup>th</sup> 1842  
Fresh winds from the Eastward cruising to the Southward of Pleasant Island spoke the Lagrange 10 days after boat in sight

Wednesday July 6  
Fresh breeze from the Eastward cruising off the Island 7 numbers of Canoes came along side 3 Barques in sight

Thursday July 7  
These 24 hours fresh breeze from the Eastward cruising off the Island 2 Canoes came off Saw 1 Barque

Friday July 8  
Light winds from the Eastward cruising off Pleasant Island Saw Blackfish

Saturday July 9  
Fresh breeze from the S & steering by the wind to the S & broke out for broad and winter today Lat by Obs 12 North Long 16 1/2 S East

Sunday July 10  
Fresh winds from the S & cruising on the line cut 2 boats night called all anchors to reef repairs in a squall split the bit at 6 AM bent a new bit Lat 13 North Long 16 1/2 S East

Monday July 11  
Light winds from the Eastward cruising near the line Saw Barques and killers broke out for Lat 13 South Long 16 1/2 S East
