Saturday May 7th 1842

Light winds from the Eastward steering by the
at Sunset look in sail Lat 56°S Long 175°28'

Sunday May 8th

Light winds from the Eastward steering
at 10 A.M. Raised the land Siglenham Island
Lat by Obs 0°57' Long by Chro 174°57'

Monday May 9th

Light winds from the Eastward steering
by the wind on both tacks at 1 P.M. Raised the
land the Island of Siglenham
Lat by Obs 0°01' South Long by Chro 174°30'

Tuesday May 10th

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising for
Whales at 1 P.M. Raised Sperm Whales and lower
4 Boats for them the Starboard boat drew
and Bow boat speared the Waist and Starboard
boats took their Whales along side and cut them
in got them cut in at Sunset Saw the
Endorby Islands and Woodl Islands
Lat by Obs 0°10' North Long by Chro 173°58'

Wednesday May 11

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising
finished trying out at 2 P.M. the Woodl Islands
in sight bearing NNE and the other NNE

Thursday May 12

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising off the Woodl
Islands at Sunset

Friday May 13th 1842

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising of the
Woodl Island until 9 A.M. we ran in to the land
and about 30 canoes came off bringing Coconuts,
Shells &c to trade for tobacco at 1 P.M. kept her South

Saturday May 14th

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising for Whales
Nothing in sight Lat 0°01' Long 173°00'

Sunday May 15

Light winds from the Eastward Cruising for Whales
Saw Porpoises &c Lat 0°44' Long 172°34'

Monday May 16

These 24 hours light winds from the Eastward,
Saw too last night until daylight when we kept
her off, W.N.W. Saw Grampuses, Warrish the Ship
Waist, Lat by Obs 0°57' South, Long by Chro 171°54'

Tuesday May 17

These 24 hours light winds from the Eastward
steering West under all sail Nothing in sight
Lat by Obs 0°43' Long by Chro 171°15'

Wednesday May 18

Light winds from the Eastward Saw too until
daylight when we kept her off S.W. by W. at 3
P.M. Raised the Cocon Islands bearing W.S.W.
Caught a few Spanish Mackerel
Lat by Obs Long by Chro
