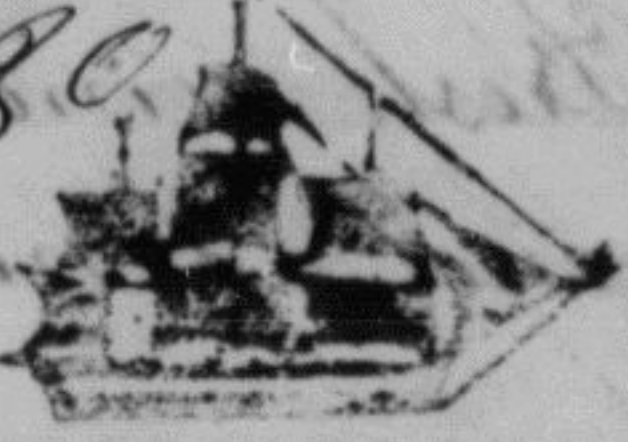


48 Journal of Whaling Voyage kept on board Ship

Boat fastened and killed, took him along
side at 12 o'clock at night



Thursday February 3
Light winds from the Eastward called all
hands at daylight and cut in our whale
got him cut in at 11 AM and commenced
trying saw at 12 o'clock Lat 55 Long 168 30



Friday February 4
Light winds from the Eastward steering
by the wind trying at 4 PM raised Sperm
Whales and lowered the Boats for them
the Main Boat struck and bow boat killed
took him along side and cut him
in and started the tryworks



Sat 45 Long 168:00
Saturday February 5
Light winds from the N E steering by the
wind at 10 AM finished trying out and raised
Sperm Whales and lowered the Boats for them
the Harboard Boat struck and crew came
on board at noon at 1 PM saw more Whales
but they too far off to lower Lat 60 37 Long 168 25

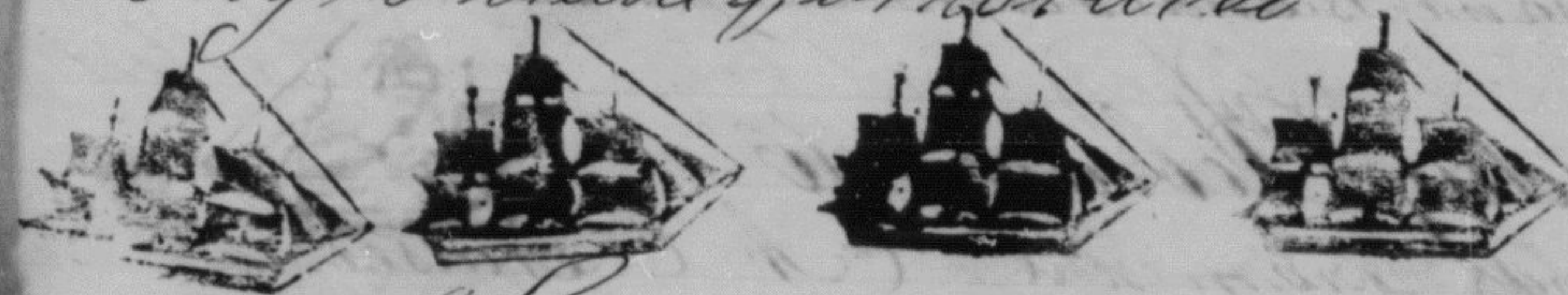
Sunday February 6
Light winds from the N E steering by the
wind, Pleasant Island bearing W S W
Saw Parbuck Blackfish &c Lat 45 Long 168

Monday February 7
Light winds from the N E steering by the wind
stayed down our Lat 65 E to day Saw Nothing
day Lat 65 E Long 168

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Tuesday February 8 1842
Light winds from the N E steering by the wind Saw
Pleasant Island at 2 PM raised Pleasant Island bearing
W S W Lat 60:54 Long 167:43

Wednesday February 9
Light winds from the E N E steering by the
wind Pleasant Island in sight bearing West
at 1 PM raised sperm Whales and lowered
4 Boats for them the Harboard Boat started
and missed Got more number of Canoes
came off to trade bringing fowls Flats and
1 Hog to trade for Pelaxes



Thursday February 10
Light winds from the N E cruising for Whales
Pleasant Island in sight to the Westward
Saw 4 Sails

Friday February 11
Fresh gales from the N E steering by the
wind to the Eastward Lat 60 37 Long 168

Saturday February 12
Fresh winds the Northward steering by the wind
at 5 PM raised Cecum Island bearing E by N
Saw 2 Sails Lat 60 45 S Long 169:15 Threw 1 Hog



Sunday February 13
Light winds from the N E steering by the wind
stayed down our Lat 65 E to day Saw Nothing
day Lat 65 E Long 168
