Sunday October 3rd 1841

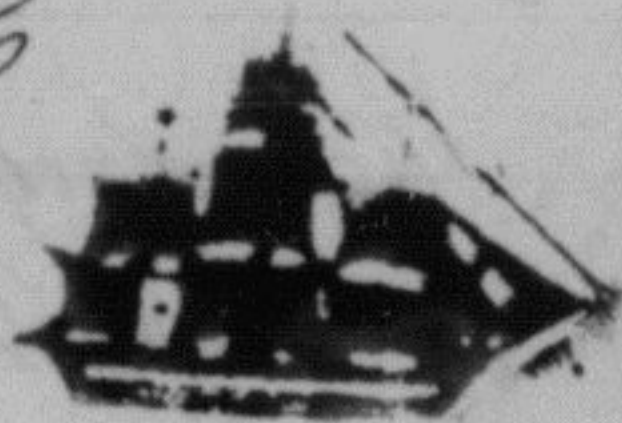
Fine weather with a light breeze from the Eastward, steering on the wind to the Southward under all sail Lat 31:10 Long 99:41 So Ends

Monday October 4th 1841

This day commences with a light breeze from E to W steering by the wind and E by N under all sail Sent up our Fore and Mizzen Royal masts and rigged out our Fly jib boom Saw Humpbacks scattered down the Starboard Mizzen rigging Lat 31:05 Long 101:02 So Ends

Tuesday October 5th

Fresh gales from the Westward to South steering E by N under all sail, Scattered down the Foretopmast rigging, Saw one Sail Lat 29:54 Long 103:40 So Ends



Sent up our main Royal Mast

Wednesday October 6

A light breeze from the S by E steering E by N under all sail Scattered the Starboard Mainmast rigging, Saw a sail steering E by N



Thursday October 7th

A light breeze from the Southward steering E by N and N by E under all sail sent up the main Royal yard Saw Sulphur bottoms Lat 28:44 Long 104:54

Friday October 8

Fresh S E trades steering N E and N E by N under all sail Saw nothing Lat 25:45 Long 109:30

Saturday October 9th 1841

Fresh trades steering N E by N and N E saw Humpbacks Pinbacks and Humpers So Ends Lat 23:25 Long 111:00 So Ends

Sunday October 10 1841

First part fresh and latter part light trades steering N N E and N E under all sail Lat 26:30 Long 111:59 So Ends

Monday October 11

A light breeze from S W to W steering N E mended the mainsail and foretop sail Saw Pinbacks Lat 19:42 Long 113:15 So Ends

Tuesday October 12

A light breeze from S W to S W steering N E by N under all sail Saw Pinbacks Lat 17:09 Long 113:48 So Ends

Wednesday October 13

A moderate breeze from the S W to S W steering N E by N under all sail Cooped our Breach between Decks Lat 15:20 Long 114:52

Thursday October 14

A light breeze from the Southward steering N E and E by N Lat 13:19 Long 116:25 Got our anchors on to the Boaz Saw Nothing So
