

Journal of a Voyage kept on board Ship

Wednesday June 9th 1841
A light breeze from the S.W. steering E.N.E.
under all sail 3 Sails in sight. Dotted
our cutting pennants and sent them aloft
Lat 35° 55' Long 66° 40'

Thursday June 10th 1841
A light breeze from the Westward steering
E. By S. under all sail 1 Sail in sight
Employed in fitting our cutting gear
Lat 36° 6' Long 68° 00'

Friday June 11th 1841
A stiff breeze from the Westward with frequent
squalls of wind and rain steering E. By S.
untill noon when we kept her off E.N.E.
under all sail Lat 35° 56' Long 68° 03'

Saturday June 12th 1841
A stiff breeze from the Westward steering
E. By S. under all sail untill 7 P.M. when
we took in the Fore and Mizen topsails and
close reefed the Main Saw 1 sail to day

Sunday June 13th 1841
This day commences with a stiff breeze
the Westward steering E. By S. under close
reefed Main topsail and fore sail 2 at in
the morning it dies away and we make all sail
noon some rain squalls during the night
Lat 38° 14' Long 67° 35'

Monday June 14th 1841
Commences with a stiff breeze from the West
with frequent squalls of wind and rain

at 6 P.M. dies away calm and at 10 P.M. rises
up again from the Westward steering E. under
all sail Saw 1 Big standing to the Eastward

Tuesday June 15th 1841
This day commences with a light breeze from the
Westward steering E. By S. at 12 noon kept E. By S.
at 4 P.M. took in Topgallantsails and headed
attack the Mainyard Lat Long 32° 20'

Wednesday June 16th 1841
A stiff breeze from the S.W. day to last night
with the Mainyard there and this morning
kept her off E. By S. at 2 P.M. double reefed
the topsails and at 6 took in the Mainsail
Jib and Mizen topsail Saw Blackfish and Dolphins
Lat 39° 39' Long 49° 10'

Thursday June 17th 1841
A stiff breeze from the S.W. steering E. By S.
untill 11 P.M. when we headed her on the
wind under double reefed topsails Saw 1 Sail
and a plenty of Dolphins Lat 39° 25' Long 48° 00'

Friday June 18th 1841
A stiff breeze from the Westward steering
on the wind to the Southward under
double reefed topsails 2 sails in sight
Lat 38° 44' Long 44° 14'

Saturday June 19th 1841
A stiff breeze from the Westward steering
on the wind to the Southward under double reefed
topsails at 6 P.M. took in
Jib, Fore and Mizen
Lat 37° 59' Long 43° 22'
