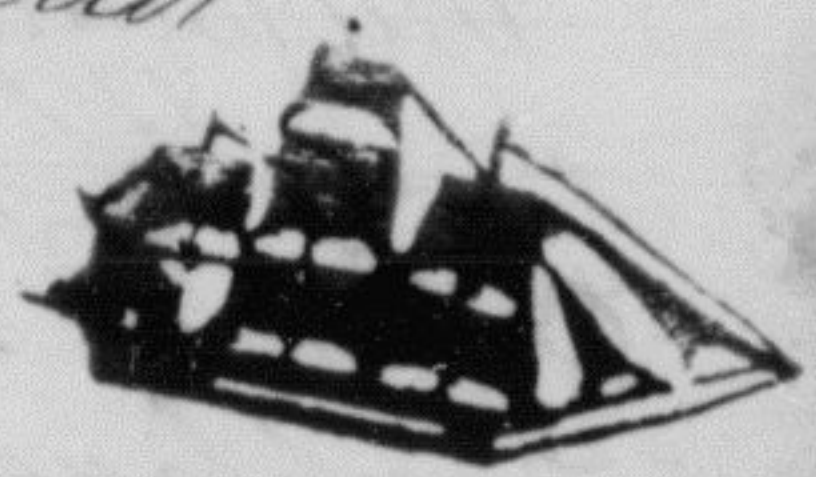


wood Ship Sharon of Fair Haven Capt Morris

Thursday June 3rd 1841

Commences with a calm but breezes up about noon lay too last night this morning made sail and kept her on the wind to the Eastward at 7 P.M. took in sail and bore her too Saw A M Brig standing to the Southward broke out for Bread



Friday June 4th

A light breeze from the N E lay too last night and made sail this morning and stood on the wind to the Eastward

Saturday June 5th

A light breeze from the Westward steering S E by E with all sail out I had very bad attack of the Gramp to day

Sunday June 6th

A light breeze from the Westward steering S E by E until 5 P.M. when we kept her under all sail Saw 2 Brigs and A Ship standing to the Southward Saw some squirts to day

Monday June 7th

A light breeze from the Southward steering S E under all sail Saw 2 sails to day

Tuesday June 8th

A light breeze from the Westward steering S N E under all sail Saw 2 sails to day
