 a whistle gut some fish so ends

Monday July 16

Comes with light South winds and heavy
 weather Sch heading S.W. all sail out
 middle part headed West latter part wind
 dratted to South west saw a sperm whale
 going to S.W. did not lose the boats so far
 away so ends Lat 34.35 Long 52.30

Tuesday July 17

Comes with light S.W. winds and heavy weather
 Sch heading on different Tacks middle part
 the same latter part saw a whale going S.W.
 Kewick lost the boats but did not see the
 whale again so ends

Wednesday July 18

Comes with light S.W. and W.S.W. winds
 Sch heading to the South all sail out
 middle part took in sail and laid the
 latter part strong W.S.W. winds headed on
 different Tacks so ends

Thursday July 19 1906

Comes with strong W.S.W. winds and clear
 Sch heading on different Tacks middle part
 short sail headed North latter part headed
 South saw a large whale heading East lost
 the boats and starboard boat struck and gut
 the whale so ends

Friday July 20

Comes with light N.W. winds and clear
 Sch sailing with a whale middle part the same
 latter part cut the whale in and spack an Italian
 ship bound to Melbourne and from New York so ends

Saturday July 21

Comes with light air from the North and clear
 weather Sch heading to the N.E. and Bayling
 middle and latter part calm so ends

Lat 34.13 Long 52.11

Sunday July 22

Comes with calm and clear weather Bayling
 middle and latter part the same gut throo
 Bayling and stow some oil so ends

Monday July 23

Comes with light air from S.W. and clear
 weather Sch heading S.E. all sail out and
 stow down oil middle and latter part
 light breezy from S.W. and clear
 Sch heading S.E. all sail out so ends
