 middle and latter part N.E. Winds
 and Clear Sch headed N.W. all sail out
 saw a Carckes So ends
 Lat 32.47 Long 51.56

Thursday July 26
 Comes With good Breeze from N.E. and
 Squally Sch heading N.W. all sail out
 middle part Short Sail latter part
 made sail and headed N.W. Wind S.W. &
 So ends Lat 32.59 Long 52.33

Friday July 27
 Comes With Strong Breeze from E.N.E.
 and Clear Sch heading North all sail out
 middle part took in sail and wore Round
 to the S.E. latter part Strong Winds from E.S.E.
 saw 2 sperm Whales heading E.S.E. - One the Boat L.B.
 struck but lost the whale the sperm drew out got nothing
 So ends Lat 33.21 Long 52.19

Saturday July 28
 Comes With Strong S.E. Winds and Clear Weather Sch heading
 on different Tacks middle part Short Sail latter
 part made sail and headed on different Tacks
 Saw nothing So ends
 Lat 33.22 Long 52.15

Sunday July 29 1906
 Comes With light S.E. Winds and Clear Weather
 Sch heading S.W. all sail out middle part
 Short Sail latter part headed N.E. all sail
 out So ends Lat 33.13 Long 52.23

Monday July 30th
 Comes With light S.E. Winds and Clear Weather
 Sch heading N.E. middle part the same
 latter part Calm So ends
 Lat 34.17 Long 51.56

Tuesday July 31
 Comes With light air from E.S.E. and
 Clear Weather Sch heading N.E. all sail
 out middle part Short Sail latter part
 made sail and headed N.E. by the Wind
 Clear Weather So ends
 Lat 34.50 Long 51.27

Wednesday August 1st
 Comes With light air from E.S.E. and
 Clear Weather Sch heading N.E. all sail
 out middle part Short Sail latter part
 Calm Spoke Italian Bank Regina Coeli
 from Genova Bound to Bridgewater Nova Scotia
 and saw a Barquentine So ends
 Lat 35.28 Long 51.19

Thursday Aug 2
 Comes With calm and Clear Weather
 middle and latter part light N.E.
 Winds and Clear Spoke the Bantha
 Bojilling and saw a H. masted Ship
 Bound West So ends
 Lat 35.05 Long 50.56
