 Comes with strong breeze from North and N.N.E. and clear weather Sch heading S.W. & Under Short Sail Pico and Fayal in sight Middle part on different Tacks latter part - Came to Anchor in Island of Fayal So Ends

From this date tel 17th
 Working on different galls about the Sch. So forth 9 men departed and Westward

Sunday Sept 17
 Came out from Fayal and headed on different Tacks to the South Wind South light and clear weather middle and latter part calm Sch on the South side of Pico So Ends
~~Lat 38 17 Long 28 27~~

Tuesday Sept 18
 Comes with calm and clear weather Sch on South side of Pico middle and latter part the same So Ends
 Lat 38 17 Long 28 27

Wednesday Sept 19
 Comes with calm and clear weather Sch on the South side of Pico Land 20 miles off middle light and from South Sch heading S.E. latter part the same Pico Saint George and Terceira in sight and Saint Miguel So Ends
 Lat 37 50 Long 27 04

Thursday September 20 1906
 Comes with light S.S.W. winds and clear weather Sch heading S.E. and S.E. by S all sail out middle part calm one steamer in sight San Black fish latter part calm and clear Saint Miguel and Santa Maria in sight So Ends
 Lat 37.21 Long 26.06

Friday Sept 21
 Comes with calm and clear weather two islands in sight middle and latter part light airs from S.E. Sch heading to S.W. So Ends
 Lat 36.50 Long 26 44

Saturday Sept 22
 Comes with light airs and calm Sch heading to S.S.W. middle and latter part good breeze from East and clear Sch heading South all sail out So Ends
 Lat 35.13 Long 26.06

Sunday Sept 23
 Comes with light winds and clear weather Wind East Sch heading South middle part Wind E.S.W. latter part light airs from E.S.E. So Ends
 Lat 32.55 Long 25.10

Monday Sept 24
 Comes with light airs from E.S.E. and clear weather Sch heading South all sail out middle part the same latter part good light breeze and squally So Ends
 Lat 30.59 Long 25.15
