 Comes with light ENE winds and
 clear weather heavy sea running
 Sch heading SSW Short sail middle
 and latter part the same with rain
 So ends Lat 32 10 Long 43, 30

Sunday Nov 4
 Comes with strong south winds and thick
 weather Sch heading SW with short
 sail middle part the same latter part
 wind SE strong Sch heading to the
 south So ends
 Lat 33 00 Long 43.58

Monday Nov 5
 Comes with strong SE winds and
 cloudy weather Sch heading to the south
 with short sail middle and latter
 part strong NE and cloudy Sch
 headed SW So ends
 Lat 34 15 Long 44 35

Tuesday Nov 6
 Comes with strong NE winds and heavy
 sea running Sch heading SSW under
 short sail middle part headed to the
 north latter part wind hauled to west
 and rain So ends
 Lat 34.15 Long 44.50

Wednesday Nov 7
 Comes with strong winds from west and
 came round to SW and clear Sch head
 NWN Short sail saw Fenwick's middle
 part the same latter part headed NWN by
 windy all sail out So ends
 Lat 34 12 Long 45.40

Thursday November 8 1906
 Comes with light winds and clear weather
 Sch heading WNW by the wind all sail out
 middle part calm latter part a gale from
 NWN and blew Sch heading to the westward under
 try sails saw a Bark standing to the east short
 sail So ends
 Lat 34.16 Long 46.23

Friday Nov 9
 Comes with a fresh gale from NWN and
 clear Sch heading to the westward with try sails
 Lying to middle part the same rain squally
 latter part wind came round to SSW strong
 Sch headed west short sail saw Fenwick's
 So ends Lat 34.35 Long 47.17

Saturday Nov 10
 Comes with strong winds from SSW
 and squally Sch heading west try sail
 fore sail and gills middle moderate latter
 part strong NW winds Sch heading WSW
 saw a Bark steering SE and took in sail
 and tack to the north So ends
 Lat 34.10 Long 47.56

Sunday Nov 11
 Comes with strong winds from NW and
 cloudy Sch heading to the NNE short
 sail middle part came with heavy squalls
 with rain thunder and lightning and heavy gale
 from NW and came round to SSW blowing hard
 Sch heading to the westward with reef try sails
 gut things out of the boats So ends
