 Comes with strong E S E winds and cloudy sea heading S. S. E. with Tyn sails and stay sail middle and latter part blowing a strong gale from East and very dark weather sea heading to the S E under Reeft Tyn sails and Reeft stay sail heavy sea running took things out the Boats So Ends
 Lat 36.20 Long 50.23

Wednesday Nov 21
 Comes with strong gale from East and very dark weather sea heading to the S E under Reeft Tyn sails heavy sea running middle and latter part the same squally and blowing to So ends - Lat 36.50 - Long 50.08

Thursday Nov 22
 Comes with gale from East and headed to S E with squally and rain heavy sea running cross sea sea heading to the South under Reeft Tyn sails at 2 P M Wore Round to N E middle part the same come with rain squally at 8 saw a large whale heading West got the Boats Red but did not see them again Strong winds and cloudy - So Ends
 Lat 36.35 Long 50.00

Friday Nov 23
 Comes with strong East winds and squally heavy sea running sea heading to the N E with short sail middle part the same latter part headed S. S. E. Lat the main sail saw a large whale heading N. W. low in Boats and S. B. got the whale and took it to the ship saw a ship steaming S. W. took in sail and took it with the whale Lat 36.18 Long 50.10

Saturday November 24 1906
 Comes with light winds and clear weather sea heading with a whale no sail out but the whale in and started the Feins weather calm and smooth So Ends
 Lat 36.03 Long 50.37

Sunday Nov 25
 Comes with calm and clear weather Bayling middle part light N. W. winds latter part strong winds sea heading to the N E short sail and Boiling So Ends
 Lat 36.17 Long 50.37

Monday Nov 26
 Comes with strong N. W. winds and clear weather sea heading to the N E under short sail and Boiling middle part boodown a strong winds and heavy sea running took things out the Boats and Batendown the Boats latter part the same saw a 4 masted ship Bound South weather very dark So Ends
 Lat non Long 50.19

Tuesday Nov 27
 Comes with strong N. W. winds and thick cloudy weather and rain squally the wind halled to West and South very dark weather started Boiling heavy sea running from N. W. middle part Rain storm boodown sea heading W. S. W. with Tyn sail and stay sail stow some oil down latter part started Boiling weather squally and strong winds saw a Bark heading to the East Wore Round to E. S. E. So Ends
 Lat 35.50 Long 51.19
