Comes with strong S W winds and
squally and heavy sea running S E
heading W S E and Baillings Boat in
sight middle and latter part the same
get three Baillings S. Ends

Monday Dec 24

Comes with light winds from S W and
clear sea heading on different tack. Boat
in sight the Bertha middle and latter part
calm manded the main sail and stow
down so ends

Tuesday Dec 25

Comes with light winds from N E and clear
sea heading S W by W middle and latter
part North winds - strong Spark the Bertha
so ends - Lat 34 11 Long 49.00

Wednesday Dec 26

Comes with strong North winds and
heavy weather sea heading W N W
middle part short sail latter part
kind south to S E and clear sea headed
N. W and North at 6 P M saw a school of
Sperm Whales heading East so late to
lose the boats so ends

Thursday December 27 1906

Comes with light E N E winds and clear
weather sea heading on different tack
middle and latter strong West winds and
squally so Whales lose the boats storm
boat held over and came with heavy
squalls lost the Whales but saw them
again with the Bark Bertha and mated
and got one whale and lost them again
and the Bertha got 1 whale went S E
so ends - Lat 34.09 Long 48 47

Friday Dec 28

Comes with strong West winds and strong
squalls with rain sea heading on different
tack with reefed sails middle and latter
part again and squally and moderate down
got one whale from the Bertha and lost it in calm
down so ends - Lat 34 28 Long 47.29

Saturday Dec 29

Comes with calm and clear got three catches
and started the works middle and latter
part calm got three Baillings sails in sight
wind halled from N to S W with strong
squally sea heading N W under short sail
so ends - Lat none - Long none

Sunday Dec 30

Comes with strong S W winds and
cloudy sea heading N W with short
sail Bertha in sight middle and latter part
strong gale with squalls so ends
