Sunday Jan 6
 Comes With Strong South winds and
 Clear Sch heading North Under Short
 Sail middle part Lade Stel latter
 part headed to the North Bertha in Sight
 So Ends Lat 34 00 Long 48.56

Monday Jan 7
 Comes With Strong E S E to East Wind
 and Cloudy Heavy Sea Running Sch headed
 to the North Middle part more Round to
 the South Short Sail latter part the same
 Strong E N E Bertha in Sight So Ends
 Lat 34 30 Long 49.00

Tuesday Jan 8
 Comes With Strong E N E and Cloudy
 Sch heading North Under Short Sail
 middle and latter part Squally Sea
 Whales heading S E lone the Boats but
 quit non on account of a Squall Bertha in
 Sight So Ends Lat 33.50 Long 49.20

Wednesday Jan 9
 Comes With Squally Weather Sch heading
 on different tack, Squally Sea Whales
 heading S E did not lose the Boats Strong
 Winds Sch heading East with Trip Sails
 middle and latter part the same
 Bertha and a nother Berk in Sight
 Lat 34 15 Long 48.32

Thursday January 10 - 1907
 Comes With Strong S E winds and Squally Weather
 Sch heading to the Eastward Under Short Sail
 middle part the same latter part headed
 South Clear Weather Bertha in Sight Spoke
 the Bark Sunbeam So Ends
 Lat 34 30 Long 48.08

Friday Jan 11
 Comes With Strong Winds and Clear Sch
 heading on different tack, middle part
 Short Sail headed N E latter part North
 Under Short Sail Bertha and Sunbeam
 in Sight So Ends
 Lat 33.31 Long 48.36

Saturday Jan 12
 Comes With Strong East Winds and Heavy
 Weather Sch heading to the North with Short
 Sail middle part the same latter part
 Moderate Weather and Cloudy Sunbeam in
 Sight So Ends Lat non Long non

Sunday Jan 13th
 Comes With light air and calm and dark Rain
 Weather Sch with Trip Sails and Stay Sail middle
 part Bloying a Gale from East and Rain Sch heading
 to the N. N. E Under Trip Sail and Stay Sail latter
 part same Whales lone the Boats with Berk Bertha
 and quit 2 - but them in and started Bloying So Ends
 Lat 33 48 Long 49.03
