Lat 33 43 Long 48.50

Wednesday Jan 16
Comes with Strong Breeze from S.W. and
Clear Sch heading E.N.E. under Short
Sail Middle and latter part Strong
Gale from S.W. to N.W. and back to
N.W. and heavy Rain Squalls Sch
Running E.N.E. under Reefed Try sails
Bertha in sight Cloft too on Port Tack
So Ends Lat non Long non

Thursday Jan 17
Comes with Strong West gale and Squally
and heavy Sea Running Sch laing to on
Port Tack under Reefed Try sails
Middle part the same latter part mo-
derate So Ends

Friday January 18 1907
Comes with good Breeze from South and
Clear Sch heading E.S.E. middle and
latter part Calm Saw a Large Whale
going S.W. Love the Boats and S.B.
Stroke and gut the Whale and took it
to the Sch So Ends
Lat 32.08 Long 45.45

Saturday Jan 19
Comes with light airs from N.E.
and Clear Sch laing with a Whale
and gut the Whale in and let go the head
and started the Works Boiling So Ends
Lat 32 17 Long 45 45

Sunday Jan 20
Comes with Calm and Clear Weather at
dawn Breezed up from N.E. Sch heading
E.S.E. Short sail and Boiling Middle
and latter part the same Saw two Sails
So Ends Lat 32 35 Long 44.54

Monday Jan 21
Comes with light N.E. winds and Clear
Weather Sch heading E.S.E. and Boiling
Middle part gut Throo Boiling latter part
Spack the Sunbeam and me Stand oil down
So Ends Lat 33 00 Long 44 06

Tuesday Jan 22
Comes with Strong Breeze from N.E.
and Cloudy Sch heading N.W. Short sail
Middle and latter part N.W. Sunbeam
in sight So Ends
Lat 32 33 Long 45.06
