Comes with light air from West and
Clear Weather Sky heading East all
Sail out Stowing oil down middle
latter part Moderate some one Sail flew
N E Slow oil down So Ends

Saturday Feb 23

Comes with light West Winds and Clear
Weather Sky heading N E all Sail out
middle and latter part the same 2 Sails
in sight So Ends Lat 24 00 32.58

Sunday Feb 24

Comes with light air and Calms Sky head
N by E all Sail out middle and latter
part the same one Sail in sight
So Ends

Lat 23 00 Long 33.07

Monday February 25 1907

Comes with light South Winds and Squally
Sky heading N N E all Sail out middle
and latter part good Breeze from S E
So Ends Lat 21 08 Long 33 09

Tuesday Feb 26

Comes with good Breeze from S E and Clear
Sky heading N by E all Sail out middle
and latter part Strong Breeze So Ends

Lat 18 39 Long 33.39

Wednesday Feb 27

Comes with light S E Winds and Clear
Weather Sky heading N by E all Sail out
middle and latter part Strong Winds
and Squally some Whales going Kwick
to E S E did not leave the Boats So Ends

Lat 16 30 Long 33.57

Thursday Feb 28

Comes with Strong Winds and Squally
Sky heading N N E took in the main
Sail and set the Top Sail middle
and latter part Squally same 2 Sails
leaving South Sky heading N. N. E
So Ends
