boiling and stored down some oil

later part N.W. wind and light rain
Lat 32-30

and pleasant weather Lat 33-20
Long 52-20

June 27th

This day began with strong S.W. wind squally
rain all day under the try sails and fore staysails
no C.B.s

June 28th

This day began with strong N.W. wind rain
later part clear Lat 34-25
Long 52-00

Sat

June 29th

This day began with strong Breeze from westward
rain at 2 P.M. raised whale at 3 P.M.
Boat struck at 5 got the whale along side
whales going S.E. heavy rain squally
no C.B.s

June 30th

This day began with strong N.E. wind clear cut
the whale in and start the fire so ends the day.
