 he was put in iron Lat $32-33$
 Long $50-04$

Wed July 3rd
 This day began with light Westerly wind
 all sail out morning star in sight
 no Obs

Thurs July 4th
 This day began with light N.W. wind all sail
 out jammed the Bark Morning Star
 Lat $31-40$
 Long $50-52$

Fri July 5th
 This day began with strong N.W. wind
 rain squally morning star in sight
 Lat $30-40$
 Long $51-10$

Sat July 6th
 This day began with strong N.W. wind
 squally Lat $30-50$
 Long $50-20$

Sun July 7th
 This day began with light N.W. wind
 latter parts calm Lat $31-30$
 Long $50-10$

Mon July 8th
 This day began with light Westerly wind
 clear and pleasant weather sun a sail
 bound to the Southern Lat $32-0$
 Lon $50-50$

Tues 9th
 This day began with strong S.W. rain latter
 parts clear spoke a Finnish Barkteen
 Bound for New foundland Lat $32-30$
 Long $50-55$

Wed July 10th
 This day began with light S.W. wind heavy
 weather all sail out Lat $33-10$
 Long $52-10$

Thurs July 11th
 This day began with strong S.W. wind thick
 latter parts squally Lat $34-40$
 Lon $52-10$

Fri July 12th
 This day began with moderate S.W. wind
 clear and pleasant latter parts strong Breeze
 Lat $35-40$
 Long $50-40$

Sat July 13th
 This day began with light N.W. wind clear
 and pleasant weather sun iron bang yet some
 fish Lat $33-20$
 Lon $49-04$

Sun July 14th
 This day began with strong N.W. wind
 all sail out clear weather Lat $32-40$
 Lon $49-25$

Mon July 15th
 This day began with light N.E. wind at
 9: A.M. raised a large Whale mate struck
 got the whale along side at noon
 cut the head off and got the body in
 lifted the head out side Lat $33-05$
