

Journal of a Voyage Kept on board of the

lat Obs Saturday Nov the 8 1834
26.00 Commences with rough weather
Long in at 3 PM began to cut took in the
28.30 head then lashed down at daylight
Commenced again at 11 Am finished
Cutting sent down the gear and made
sail and stood to Southward and
eastward

lat Obs Sunday Nov the 9
27.35 Commences with fresh winds and
cloudy with the watch employed
in clearing up decks middle part
Long in rainy at daylight Commenced boiling
28.00 with very muggy weather under a
Close reefed main topsail and
doubled reefed mizen topsail

lat Obs Monday Nov the 10
28.40 Commences with fresh winds and
Long in muggy with the watch employed
26.03 in boiling at 4 PM set the fore topsail
at 9 Am finished boiling and cleared
up decks and made sail

lat Obs Tuesday Nov the 11
29.30 Commences with light winds and foggy
Long in middle part rainy at daylight
24.00 breaking out the main hole for stowing
down at 12 Am finished and cleared
up the decks

lat Obs Wednesday Nov the 12
30.08 Commences with light winds and cloudy
Long in at 4 PM commenced raining middle
22.15 part calm at daylight moderate
31.11 breeze from the north east
27.20

Thursday Nov the 13
Commences with light winds
and pleasant weather middle
part calm daylight breeze
at 10 Am saw a sail to the
windward steering along with us

Ship Galen bound to the East Cape

Friday Nov the 14 1834 lat Obs
Commences with light wind with two 31.29
sail in sight middle and latter part Long in
calm latter part then got ready and 20.20
sent up new fore topmast backstays
so ends this 24 hours with a stink pot
and jenny in sight

Saturday Nov the 15
Commences with a calm and very warm lat Obs
at 4 Am light breeze from the SSE at the 31.25
studding sails middle part fresh breeze Long in
at 11 Am spoke the brig Zebra of 19.32
portsmouth eng

Sunday Nov the 16
Commences with light winds and lat Obs
pleasant weather with one sail in 30.39
sight middle and latter part calm Long in
so ends these 24 hours with pleasant 19.00
weather

Monday Nov the 17
Commences with a calm and pleasant lat Obs
weather latter part light wind 30.59
from the NE with a brig in sight this Long in
ends these 24 hours with all sail set 16.55
to advantage

Tuesday Nov the 18
Commences with light wind and pleasant lat Obs
weather the watch employed in various 32.01
jobs latter part fresh breeze so ends these 24 hours Long in
15.00

Wednesday Nov the 19
Commences with a fine breeze middle lat Obs
part freshens at daylight saw a sail 33.57
steering ESE so ends these 24 hours Long in
12.11
blowing fresh from the NW

Thursday Nov the 20
Commences with fresh wind and lat Obs
pleasant middle part breeze latter 36.11
part Doubled reefed the fore topsail Long in
the wind fresh from the NW 9.26
