

Journal of a Voyage Kept on board of the

Friday Nov the 21 1834
lat Obs 36.40
long in 7.20
Commenced with fresh winds and cloudy at 7 PM hove two under close reefed maintopsail at daylight kept her off East with fresh wind latter part moderate made sail

Saturday Nov the 22
lat Obs 36.40
long in 6.00
Commenced with light wind and cloudy at sunset took in sail at daylight saw rite whales and toward at 11 Am toward did not get fast so ends 24 hours

Sunday Nov the 23
lat Obs 35.16
long in 5.43
this day commenced with calm and whales in sight at 12 PM toward but did not get fast come on board and took in sail tick and rainey middle took in the fore sail at 7 Am close reefed the fore main topsail

Monday Nov the 24
lat Obs 35.05
long in 5.07
Commenced with a gail of wind laying two under close reefed main topsail middle moderate at daylight made all sail at 6 Am toward did not get fast at 8 Am toward did not get fast whales going quick

Thursday Nov the 25
lat Obs 34.36
long in 5.49
Commenced with light wind and pleasant at 4 PM toward two barboard boats did not get fast sunset took in sail at daylight being calm sent down the fore topsail saw whales going quick at 10 Am caught a sunfish

Wednesday Nov the 26
lat Obs 34.46
long in 2.00
Commenced with light winds at 9 PM bent the fore topsail sunset took in sail at daylight made sail at 10 Am spoke the Henry of day harbour

Ship Galen bound to the East Cape

Thursday Nov the 27 1834
lat Obs 34.20
long in 2.10
Commenced with light wind at 12 PM the waist boat fastened at 324 took him along side commenced cutting at sunset lashed down at daylight commenced again at 8 finished

Friday Nov the 28
lat Obs 34.53
long in 2.54
Commenced with moderate weather and boiling at 12 PM stood to the westward latter part fresh wind and rainey took in sail at 12 Am it cleared up and was pleasant

Saturday Nov the 29
lat Obs 34.50
long in 1.40
Commenced with pleasant weather at 8 PM finished boiling middle part rainey at daylight brook out the fore peak and stowed down so ends this 24 hours

Sunday Nov the 30
lat Obs 35.16
long in 1.45
Commenced with pleasant weather all hands employed in stowing down at 6 PM finished and took in sail at 10 Am toward the waist boat fastened and parted

Monday Dec the 1 1834
lat Obs 35.10
long in 2.00
Commenced with fresh breeze at 6 PM spoke the Margaret, sett of St Johns with 2 whales Capt went on board at 8 Am toward did not get fast at 8 Am toward did not get fast whales very wild

Thursday Dec the 2
lat Obs 35.17
long in 1.34
Commenced with light wind and foggy at 6 PM toward did not get fast middle part pleasant and light wind at 11 Am saw the Margaret Rett take a whale alongside so ends this 24 hours
