Commences with light breeze and pleasant weather this day commenced boats. Watches middle part calm at daylight saw a school of blackfish so ends there 24 hours with pleasant weather

Sunday Feb the 1 1835

Commences with light wind and pleasant weather with the watch employed in repairing sails middle part light breeze from the SW so ends there 24 hours

Monday Feb the 2

Commences with light wind and pleasant weather the watch employed in mending sails latter part strong breeze looks squally so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday Feb the 3

Commences with fresh breeze and cloudy with the watch. Repairing sails. Middle part squalls off rain latter part fresh breeze and pleasant weather

Wednesday Feb the 4

Commences with light wind and pleasant weather this night smelt the land very strong at daylight saw the island of Mohella bearing NE Dist 10 leagues and Johanna bearing West Dist 9 leagues

Thursday Feb the 5

Commences with strong breeze and pleasant weather Cruising off the SW side of Johanna at 8 AM sent a boat on shore for fruit

Friday Feb the 6

Commences with pleasant weather at 1 PM loward for school of whale did not get fast at 8 AM loward the harbor and got two at 12 AM took them along side and stood from the land

Saturday Feb the 7 1835
Commences with pleasant weather and all hands employed in cutting in at 5 PM finished and cleared up the decks at 8 PM Commenced boiling middle part calm

Sunday Feb the 8
Commences with light wind and boiling at 1 PM went on board of a Turkish Courier and got some fruit at 3 PM finished boiling and cleared up the decks middle part light breeze from NW latter part calm off the SW side of Johanna

Monday Feb the 9

Commences with calm and pleasant weather off the south part of Johanna middle part light breeze from the East latter part not warm but hot steering in for the land

Tuesday Feb the 10

Commences with light wind at 10 AM sent the boats in to the land to cruise for whale but did not see any latter part rainy

Wednesday Feb the 11

Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 9 AM a canoe came along side with fruit to trade. Stopt on board some time then went on shore middle part calm at 8 AM sent two boats on shore to trade

Thursday Feb the 12

Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 3 PM the boats returned with three bullock and a grate quantity of fruit middle part calm at daylight killed a bullock latter part stowed 24 barrels of oil at 11 AM finished
