Friday Feb the 13 1835
Commences with pleasant weather and light wind middle part calm at 12 AM Johanna bears south Dist 12 leagues from whence I take my departure for the island of Aldabra

Saturday Feb the 14
Commences with a fine breeze and pleasant weather with the watch employed in various jobs middle part cloudy wind light steering NE for Aldabra island

Sunday Feb the 15
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather middle part rainy latter part light wind and pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Monday Feb the 16
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 12 PM tacked ship and stood to the westward at 3 AM tacked stood to the eastward latter part light wind with a great number of birds in sight at 12 AM kept her off East

Tuesday Feb the 17
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 3 PM saw the Island of Aldabra East Dist 6 leagues latter part light wind

Wednesday Feb the 18
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 8 AM went on shore and took a general survey so ends these 24 hours

Thursday Feb the 19 1835
Commences with light wind at 3 PM toward the waist boat and caught a black fish at 7 PM the boats returned and sent a boat on shore for turtle at 9 AM returned with seven so ends these 24 hours

Friday Feb the 20
Commences with strong breeze and squally at 2 PM saw two ships and one schooner at daylight killed a turtle and commenced boiling a blackfish

Saturday Feb the 21
Commences with strong breeze and cloudy middle part squally at 3 AM doubled reefed the topsails with a strong breeze from the Northward

Sunday Feb the 22
Commences with fresh wind from the Northward and squally middle part moderated at daylight made all sail so ends this 24 hours Course E by N

Monday Feb the 23
Commences with fine breeze and pleasant weather middle part moderate latter part pleasant weather

Tuesday Feb the 24
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather at 11 AM saw a large school of whale toward all the boats struck the larboard boat saved two the waist boat one the starboard boats sunk

Wednesday Feb the 25
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather with all hands employed in cutting in at 9 PM commenced boiling with fine weather
