Commences with light wind and
pleasant weather at daylight saw
the sea shells Islands bearing ESE
with the wind to the at 9 AM got the
anchors on the bow and bent the larboard
chane

Thursday March the 4
Commences with pleasant weather at 4 PM
came to anchor in the harbour of Make
at breast of the ship thames of London
at daylight commenced bedging out
the wind blowing fresh gave it up at 10 AM
went on shore

Friday March the 5
Commences with pleasant weather
with the crew of the thames on board
Enjoying them selves latter part bedged of
out side of the reef reef

Saturday March the 6
Commences with fine weather at 9 AM
hove up our anchor and stood out of the
harbour of Make with a fine breeze from
the NE accompanied to the Mouth of
the harbour by Capt Croft of the ship
Amanday of New Bedford that was condemned
at the Island of Pito

Sunday March the 7
Commences with fresh breeze and rainey
bound to the Island of Plata middle
part calm latter part light breeze
and pleasant weather at 11 AM 15 fathoms
of water on the edge of the bank

Monday March the 8
Commences with light breeze and pleasant
weather at sunset took in sail layed
by until daylight then kept her off
for Plata
