Saturday April the 19 1835

Commences with fine weather at 8 AM brought off a raft of water the starboard watch went on shore and then stowed the water at 12 finished then went on shore with raft and filled it

Sunday April the 20
Commences with pleasant weather and the starboard watch on shore at sunset returned all sober this ends these 24 hours with a number of Natives on board trading

Monday April the 20
Commences with all hands employed in getting off a raft of water then the starboard watch went on shore the rest employed in painting the starboard benches

Tuesday April the 21
Commences with the starboard watch on liberty the rest employed in painting the starboard benches so ends this day at 4 PM the Pacific of Santhet came to anchor between the Harvold and us with 3.75 barrels

Wednesday April the 22
Commences with the starboard watch on liberty the rest employed in stowing down water this ends these 24 hours

Thursday April the 23
Commences with all hands on board at sunset brought on board two bullocks took the anchor to the bow in company with the Harvold and stood out from the land so ends these 24 hours

Friday April the 24
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. Cruising off S.W. part of Zohania in company with the Harvold of Gloucester middle part moderate

Saturday April the 25 1835
Commences with moderate breeze at 4 PM tacked ship stood to S.W. the North part of Manhattan bearing E by N Dist 6 miles at 10 AM saw the Harvold latter part strong breeze off the West part of Manotta so ends these 24 hours

Sunday April the 26
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather with heavy swell from the S.W. Cruising off the west part of Mayotta this 24 hours ends with moderate weather

Monday April the 27
Commences with light breeze and pleasant weather middle part rainy latter part strong breeze from the S.W. Cruising off the west side of Mayotta

Tuesday April the 28
Commences with strong breeze from the south at 6 PM left the Island of Mayotta bearing S.W. Dist 6 miles bound to Madagascar latter part moderate weather lat Obs 13.13 long in 46.11 E

Wednesday April the 29
Commences with light breeze and pleasant weather middle part had thunder and lightning latter part squally with rain lat Obs 13.01 long in 45.15

Thursday April the 30
Commences with light wind and pleasant weather middle part squally with heavy thunder and lightning latter part calm lat Obs 13.00 long in 46.38

Friday May the 1
Commences with calm and pleasant weather middle part squally latter part calm and pleasant lat Obs 13.20 long in 46.40
