at 9 AM saw the Island of Madagascar
bearing East Dist 16 leagues this 24 hours ends
with a light breeze

Sunday May the 3
Commences with light breeze in sight
of Madagascar Middle part squally
latter part light breeze
Lat Obs 13.25 long in 47.53

Monday May the 4
Commences with calm middle part
squally latter part light breeze and
pleasant weather this 24 hours ends with
Madagascar in sight Lat Obs 13.05 long in 48.02

Tuesday May the 5
Commences with light breeze and pleasant
weather at 3 PM saw school of 2 Blackfish
Middle part squally latter part light breeze
and pleasant Lat Obs 12.31 long in 47.52

Wednesday May the 6
Commences with light wind and pleasant
at 4 PM sounded in 25 fathoms on Levee Bank
Middle part squally latter part Moderate
Lat Obs 11.45 long in 48.46

Thursday May the 7
Commences with light breeze and pleasant
weather Middle part strong breeze doubled
raised the topsails latter part fresh gales from
the SSB Lat Obs 10.24 long in 48.52

Friday May the 8
Commences with strong gales and Cloudy
Middle part squally latter part light
breeze and pleasant weather
Lat Obs 9.24 long in 48.24

Saturday May the 9 1835
Commences with fine breeze and
pleasant Middle part squally with
light rain latter part pleasant weather

Sunday May the 10
Commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather at 8 AM saw a school
of blackfish this 24 hours ends with
pleasant weather

Monday May the 11
Commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather Middle part calm
latter strong breeze and squally

Tuesday May the 12
Commences with light breeze
and pleasant middle part calm
latter light breeze from the SSB

Wednesday May the 13
Commences with light breeze from
the SSB Middle part squally with
heavy thunder and lightning latter
part steady breeze

Thursday May the 14
Commences with light breeze
and pleasant weather latter
part strong breeze

Friday May the 15
Commences with strong breeze at
7 AM saw a school of whale toward
three boats struck and saved their
whale at 12 AM one boat went on board
and worked the ship to the whale

Saturday May the 16
Commences with all hands employed
in taking three whale along side
at 9 AM commenced cutting at sunset
finished at daylight commenced cutting
at 12 finished with rugged weather
