in boiling Middle part squally
at 12 Am finished and Couled downe
the woorkes with 47 barrels turned up

Monday the 18 May
Commences with strong gales and rugged
weather with all hands Employed in
Clearing up the Decks latter part
Moderate saw a large Number of
Blackfish this 24 hours ends with the waist
boat on Deck to repair

Tuesday May the 19
Commences with heavy breze from the SSE
middle part moderate at daylight broke
out the after hold and stowed downe
47 barrels of oil at 12 Am finished

Wednesday May the 20
Commences with fresh wind and
pleasant with all hands employed
in stoeing off the after hole
latter part moderate

Thursday May the 21
Commences with Moderate weather
Middle part fresh gales and squally
latter part fresh gales and pleasant
with the watch Employed in Repairing
the Main topsail so ends these 24 hours

Friday May the 22
Commences with fresh gales and rugged
weather with the watch employed in
mending Main topsail latter part
lying two under Doubled reefed main
topsail and fore sail

Saturday May the 23
Commences with heavy gale from
the SE lying two under doubled
reefed main topsail latter part
strong breze

Sunday May the 24 1835
Commences with Moderate weather
at 7 AM saw a school of whale toward
three boats and fastened and saved their
whale the larboard boat lost her line
at 12 AM took them along side ~~so ends these 24 hours with~~
~~three whale along side~~

Monday May the 25
Commences with all hands Employed in
cutting in at 6 PM finished at daylight
cleared off the heads and commenced
boiling this 24 hours ends with pleasant
weather

Tuesday May the 26
Commences with all hands Employed in
boiling at 4 PM toward for whale the waist
boat fastened and parted the starboard and
larboard about fastened at sunset took
their whale along side at 1 AM being rugged
parted one of the fluke ropes lost him
at 7 AM but in the starboard boats whale

Wednesday May the 27
Commences with strong breze with all
hands Employed in boiling at 12 PM finished
latter part of the ~~so ends these 24 hours~~
ends with pleasant weather

Thursday May the 28
Commences with rugged weather
at daylight broke out and commenced
stoeing downe at 10 saw a school of whale
toward the larboard boat struck the
starboard boat got stove the waist boat
struck and parted took the larboard
boats whale along side and finished
stoeing downe

Friday the 29 May
Commences with all hands Employed in
cutting at 10 PM commenced boiling at 11 AM
finished and Couled downe so ends these 24 hours
